

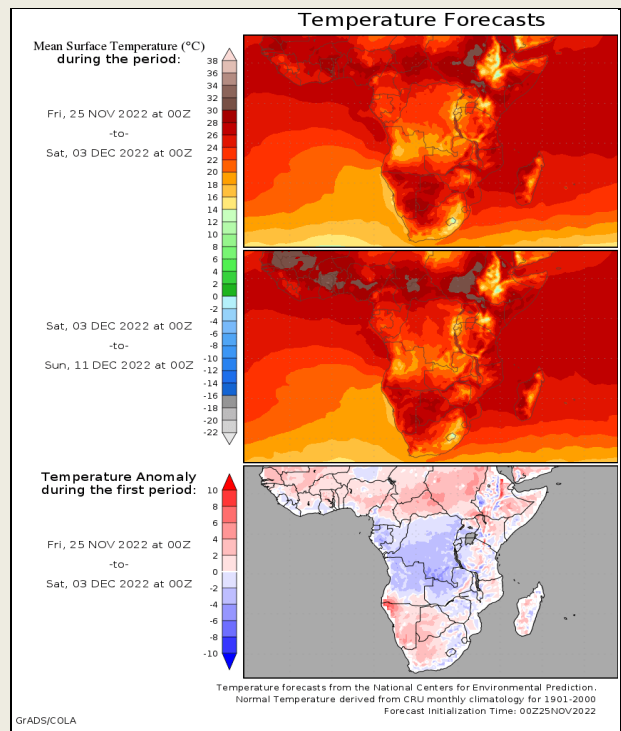
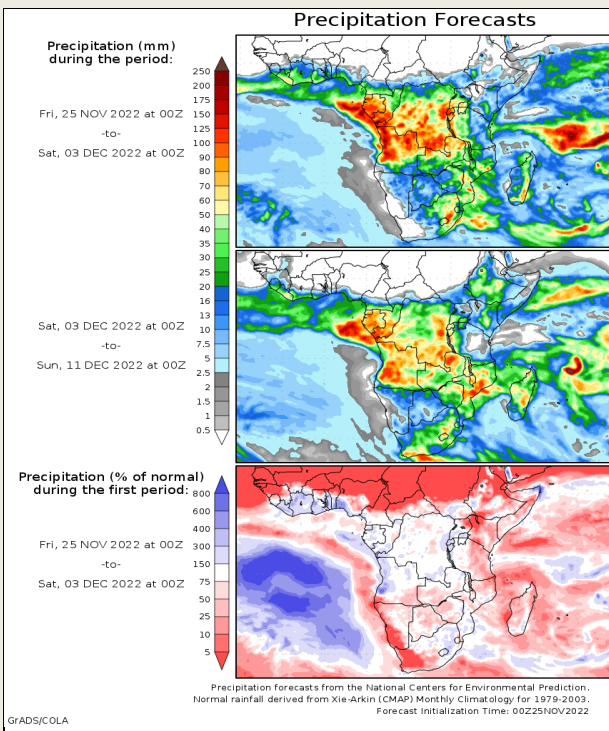
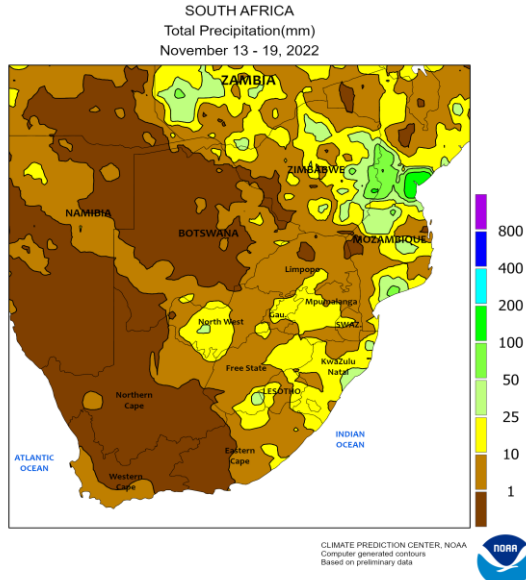
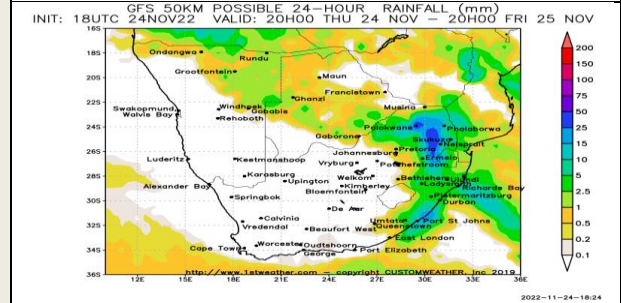
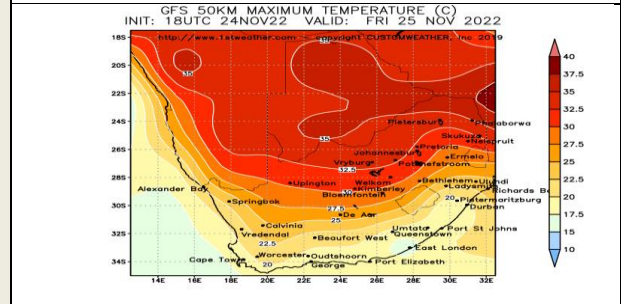
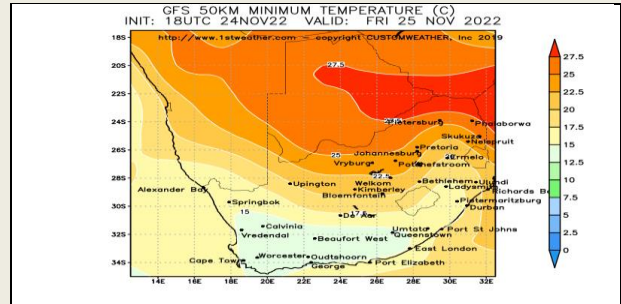


Weather Report

South Africa - Weather

SOUTH AFRICA : The eastern half of South Africa will continue to see a good mix of rain and sunshine through the middle of next week. The environment will remain favorable for aggressive coarse grain, oilseed, cotton, and other crop establishment and development conditions. Any winter wheat harvesting that is not yet complete in western and central South Africa will also advance swiftly. • Eastern and central South Africa will see a mix of rain and sunshine during the coming week • Some of the most widespread rain will evolve late Friday into early next week • Moisture totals by next Wednesday morning will range from 1.00-4.00" with locally greater amounts in Natal, Mpumalanga, and Limpopo • Free State, North West, and eastern sections of Eastern Cape will receive 0.40-3.00" of rain with drier pockets in western sections of Free State and North West • Western South Africa will be mostly dry during the coming week • Any rain that does occur will be lost to evaporation • Eastern and central South Africa will see several waves of rain December 1 – 7 • Western South Africa will be drier biased

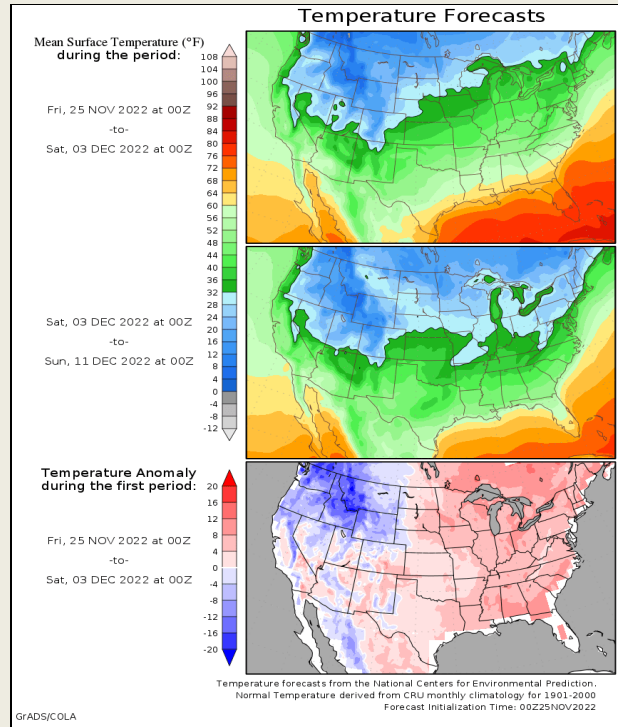
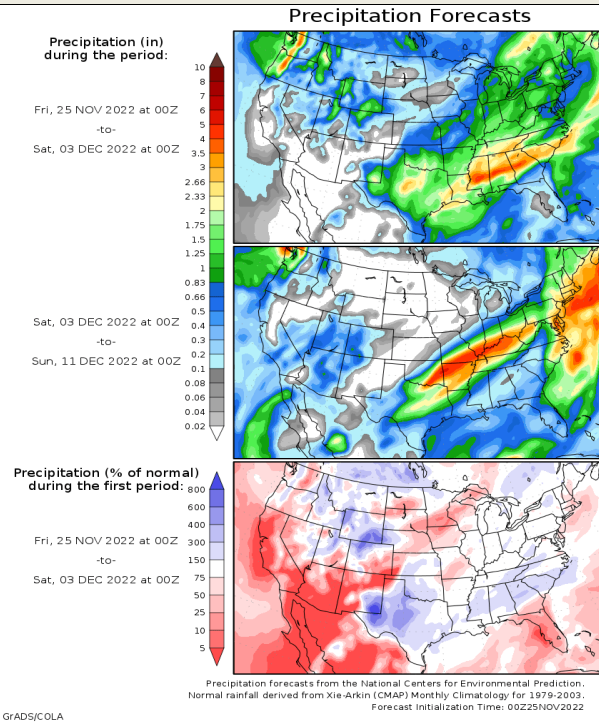
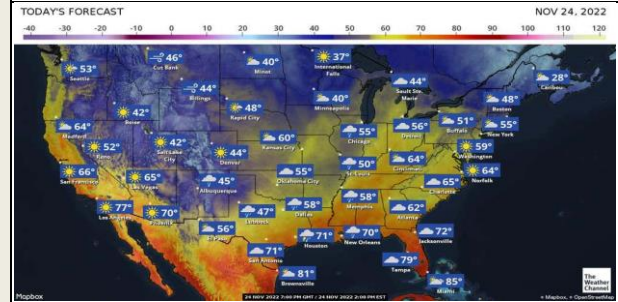
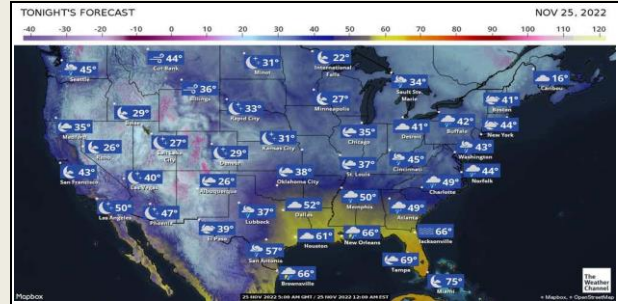


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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST : Restricted precipitation in northwestern production areas will allow any lingering late season fieldwork to advance. Precipitation is expected in the southeastern part of the region. Near to above average temperatures will likely stimulate some more wheat emergence and establishment.

U.S. DELTA : A significant rain event is expected Thursday through Saturday. Late season fieldwork is gradually ending; however, the rain will cause some delays. Near to above average temperatures will be supportive of more wheat emergence and establishment though. Rain in the southeastern states could still lead to some minor cotton quality issues. Southern Georgia will be one of the driest areas. Also, some rise in the Mississippi River water level is still possible as a result of the coming rain.

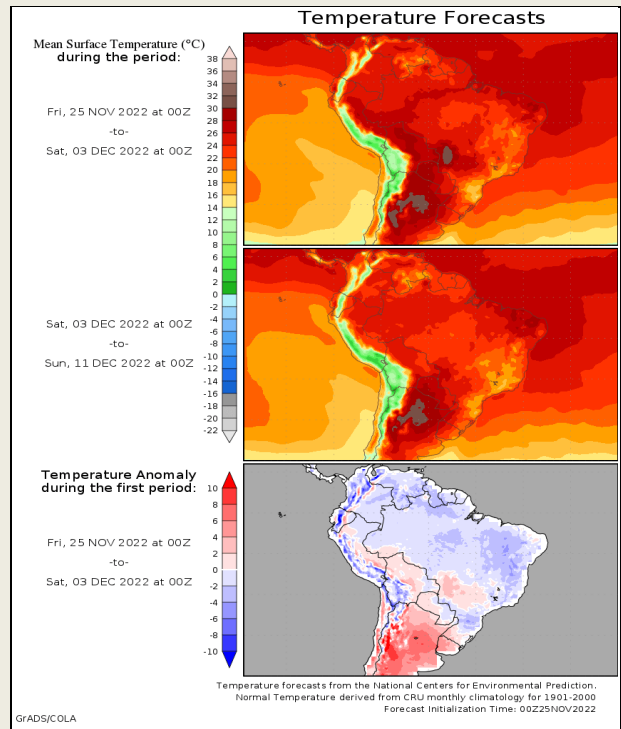
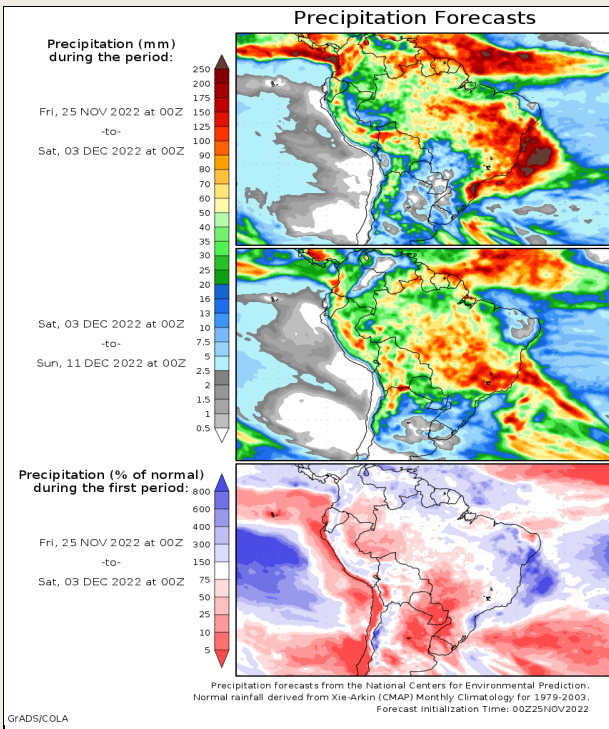
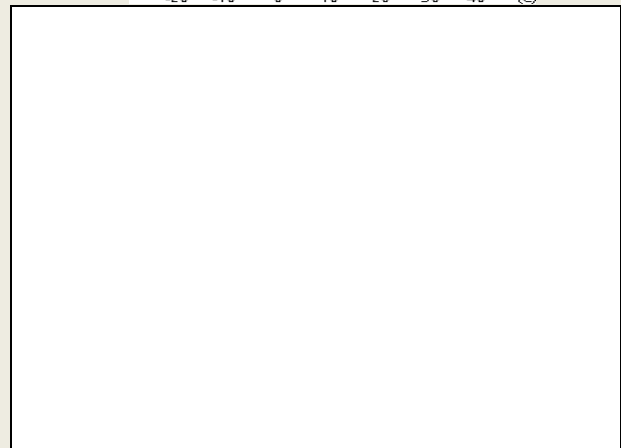
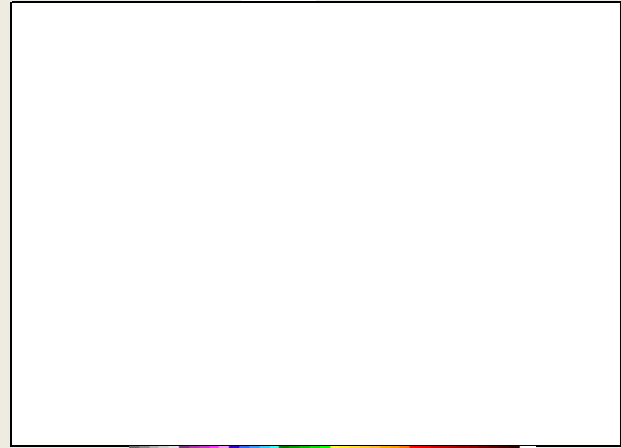


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South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Net Drying will occur from southwestern and south-central Mato Grosso through Mato Grosso do Sul to Rio Grande do Sul and Paraguay in this coming week. Any rain that falls in this region will be less than 0.50 inch and will be lost to evaporation. Rain will fall routinely from the remainder of Mato Grosso, Tocantins and Maranhao into Piaui, Bahia, Minas Gerais and Sao Paulo during the coming week. Rain totals will vary from 2.00 to 4.00 inches with many extreme amounts of 4.00 to 6.50 inches by this time next week

ARGENTINA: Excessive heat and dryness will become a bigger issue for the nation's driest areas during the next full week to possibly ten days. The hottest weather is expected in this first week of the outlook and rainfall will be minimal. Soil conditions are already too dry in Santa Fe, Entre Rios, parts of Corrientes, Chaco and southern Santiago del Estero. These are the provinces that will experience the most stress in this coming week. Soil moisture farther south is a little better, but the heat and dryness coming up will quickly deplete soil moisture and return crop moisture stress that was briefly relieved by rain in the past week.

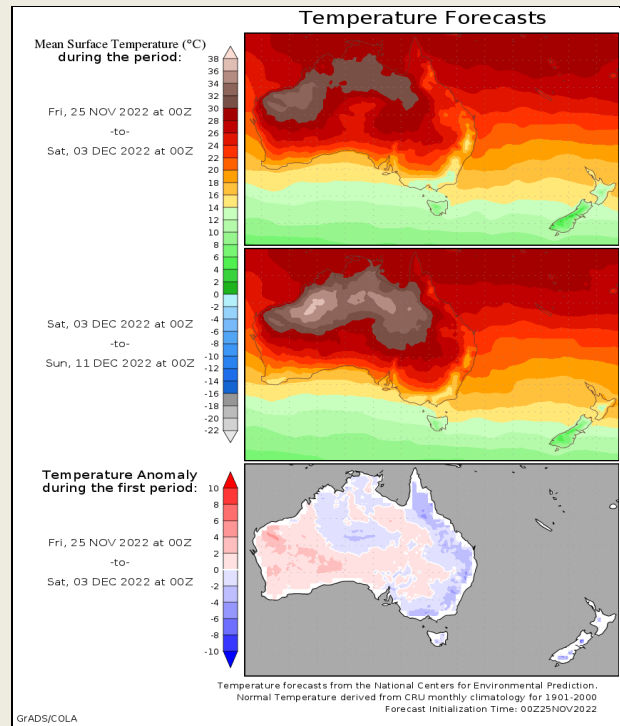
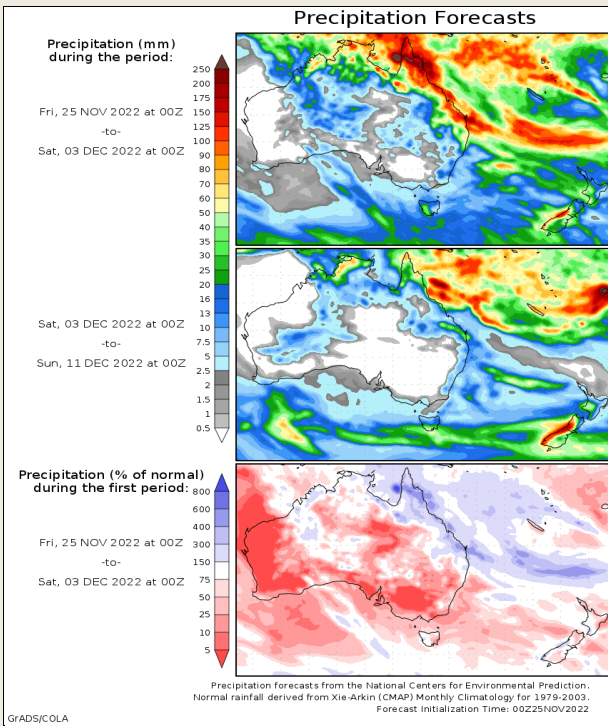
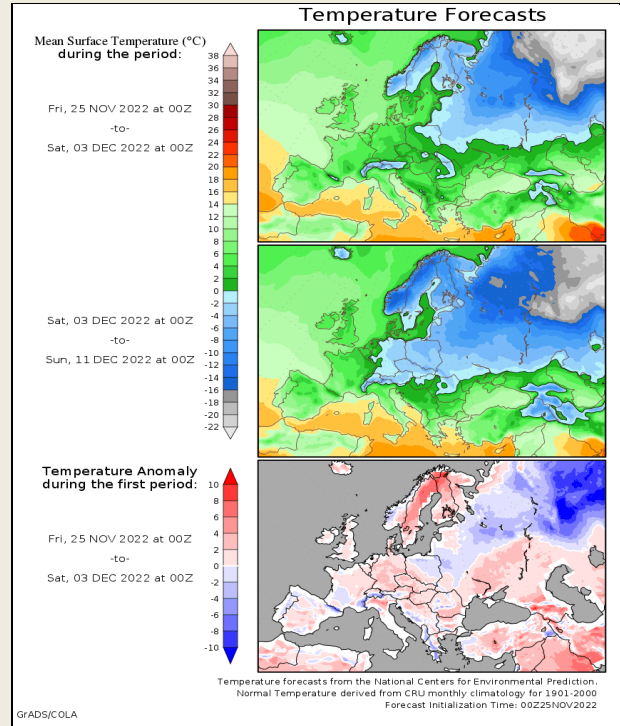
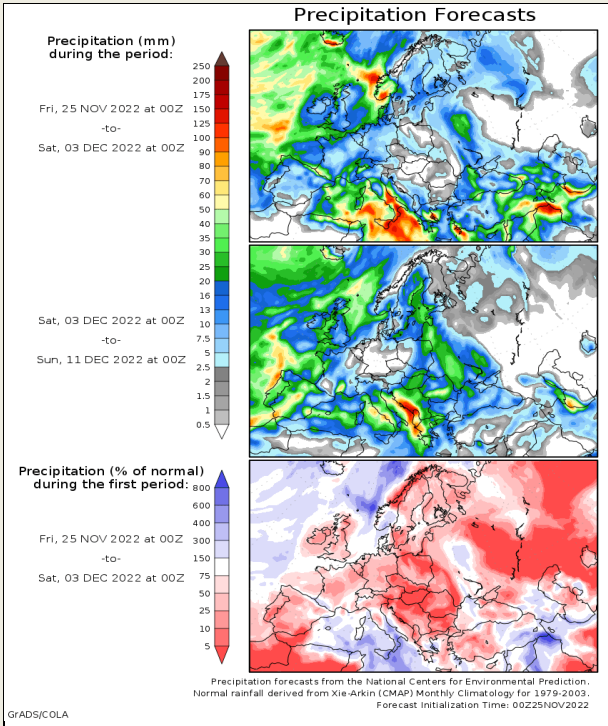


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Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE : More significant rain in Italy and the western Balkan Countries in the next seven days will likely lead to some areas of flooding. Some late season fieldwork could be delayed by the rain; however, near to above average temperatures will help with drying between areas of rain.

AUSTRALIA : Net drying is expected in a majority of the region through Saturday before rain increases in eastern areas Sunday and Monday. Some warming later this week combined with little rainfall will be beneficial for the wettest areas of the southeast. The environment will be generally favorable for fieldwork and crop development; though, the rain in the early part of next week could lead to some more fieldwork delays in the east.



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
