

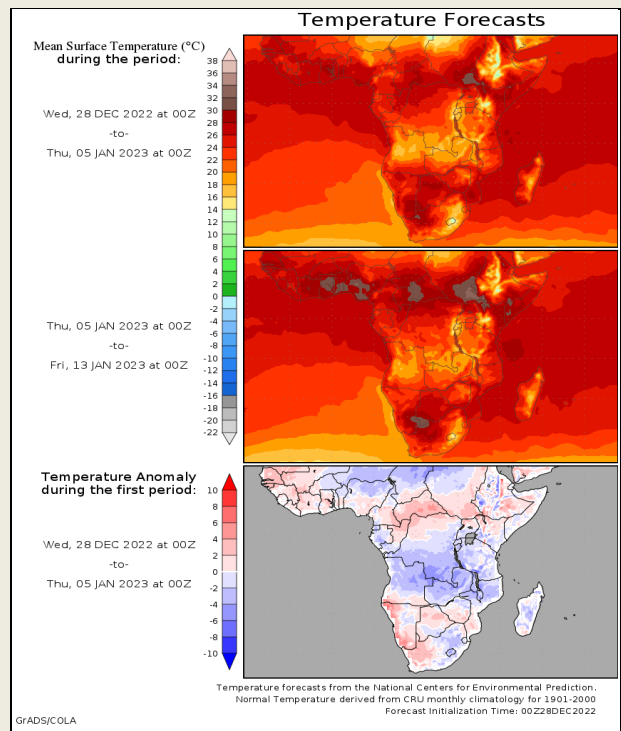
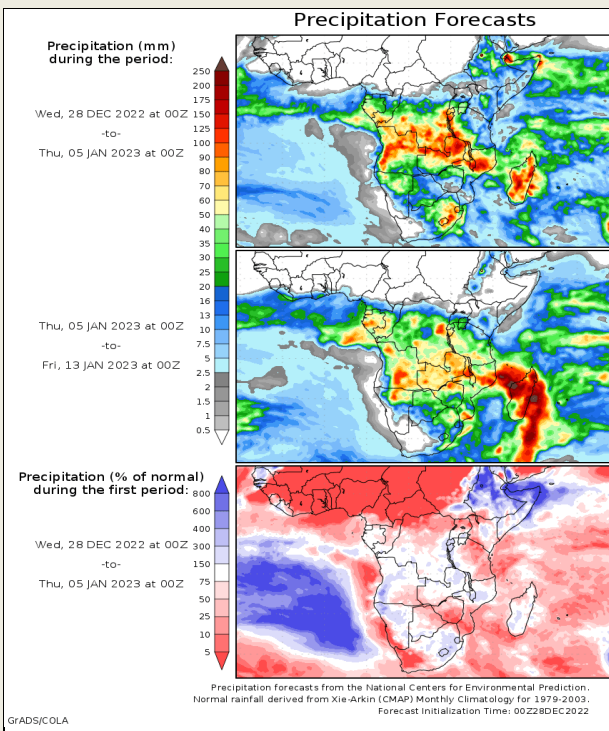
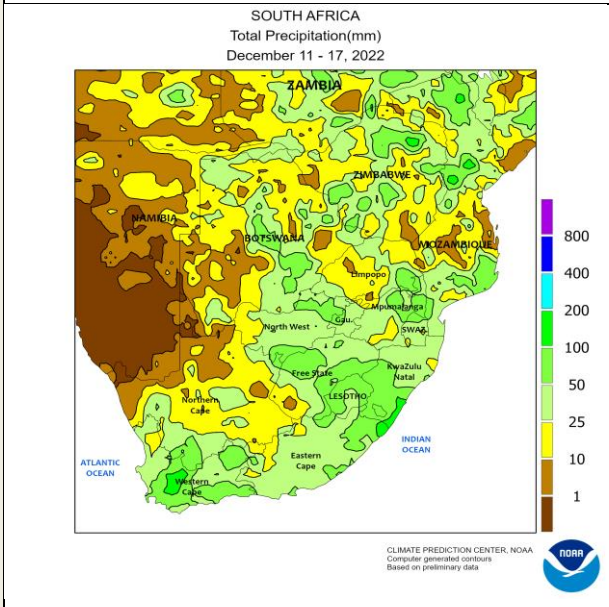
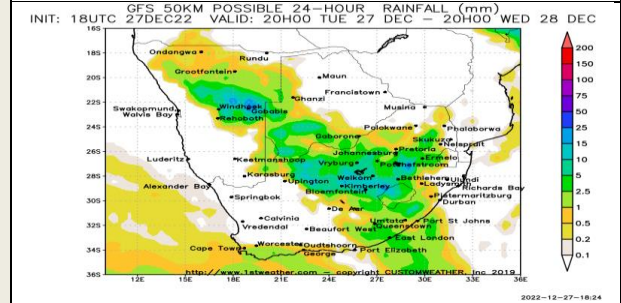
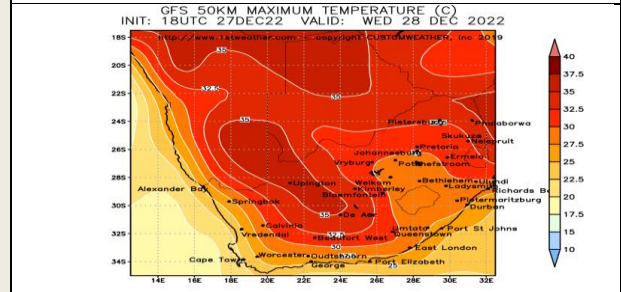
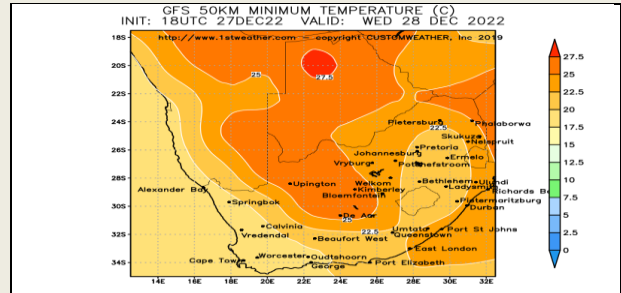


Weather Report

South Africa - Weather

SOUTH AFRICA : Significant rain in the eastern half of South Africa in the first week of the outlook will be favorable for summer crop production; though, some localized flooding is possible. Western production areas of the region will be much drier in comparison. The dryness in the west is not expected to be an issue; however, some greater rainfall would be beneficial • Daily shower and thunderstorm activity will occur in the eastern half of the region through Monday • Total moisture will vary from 1.50 to 3.00 inches, locally as much as 3.50 to 5.00 inches • Some showers and thunderstorms are likely in the western half of the region mainly Sunday and Monday • Total moisture will vary from a trace to 0.25 inch, locally more • A similar rainfall pattern is expected in the eastern half of the region in the second week, Jan. 3 – 10 • Some increase in erratic shower and thunderstorm activity is possible in the western half of South Africa

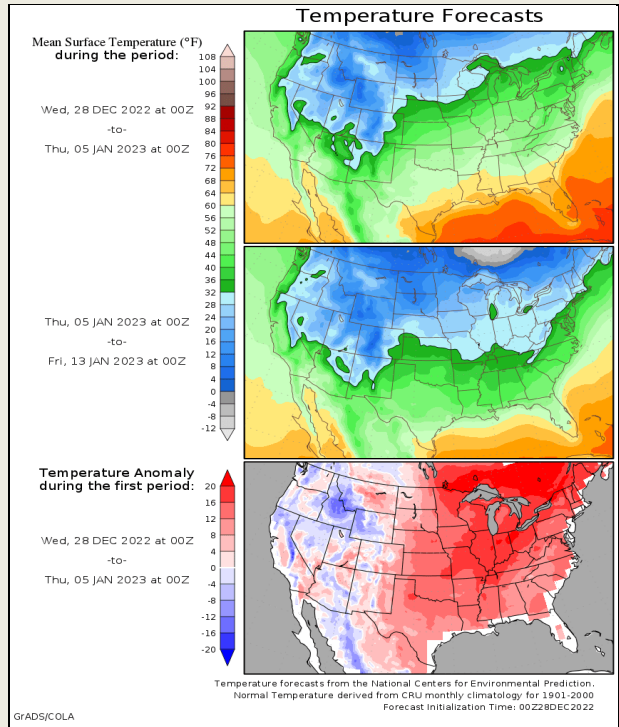
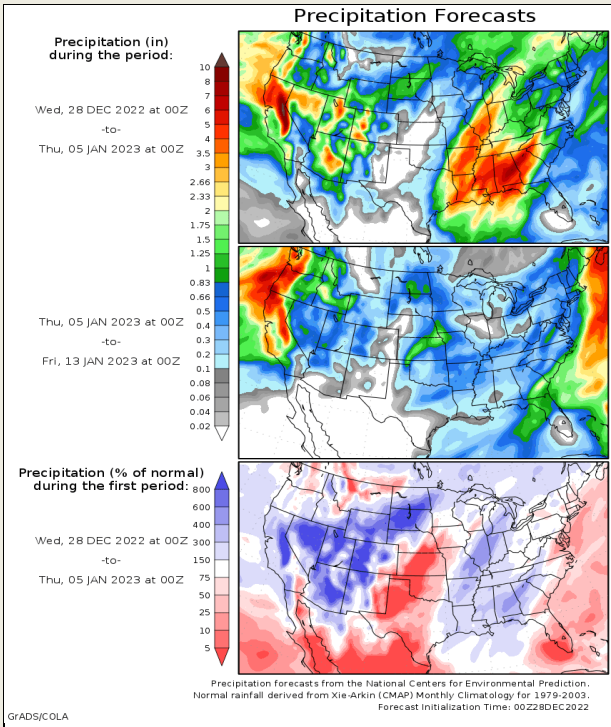
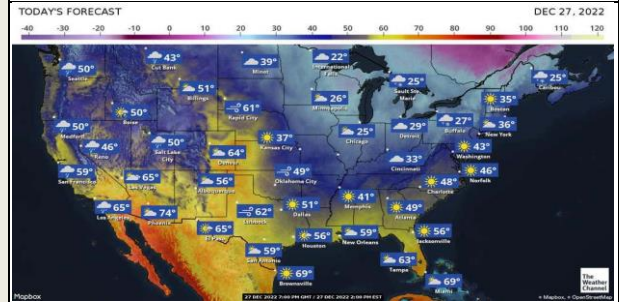
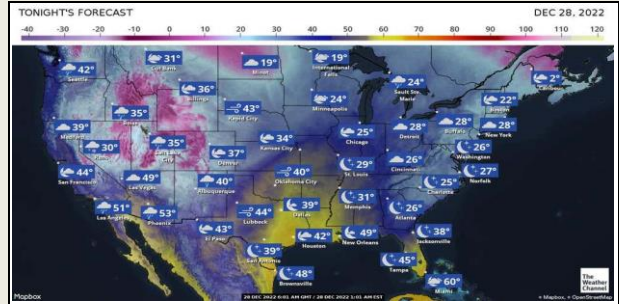

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST : Snow fell during the holiday weekend from the eastern Dakotas to northern and interior western through eastern Iowa into nearby Illinois and Wisconsin with another area of snow in Michigan and northern Ohio while snow also fell from southern Illinois and western Kentucky to south-central Indiana. Outside of precipitation events Thursday into Saturday and Monday into next Tuesday, the Midwest will see a quiet weather pattern through the next two weeks.

U.S. DELTA : Much of the Delta and the Southeast were dry during the weekend with light precipitation noted in a few locations. Two rounds of widespread rain will fall on the Delta and the Southeast Thursday into Wednesday of next week with additional rain in the Southeast the following two days leaving many areas with saturated soil while some local flooding is likely as well.

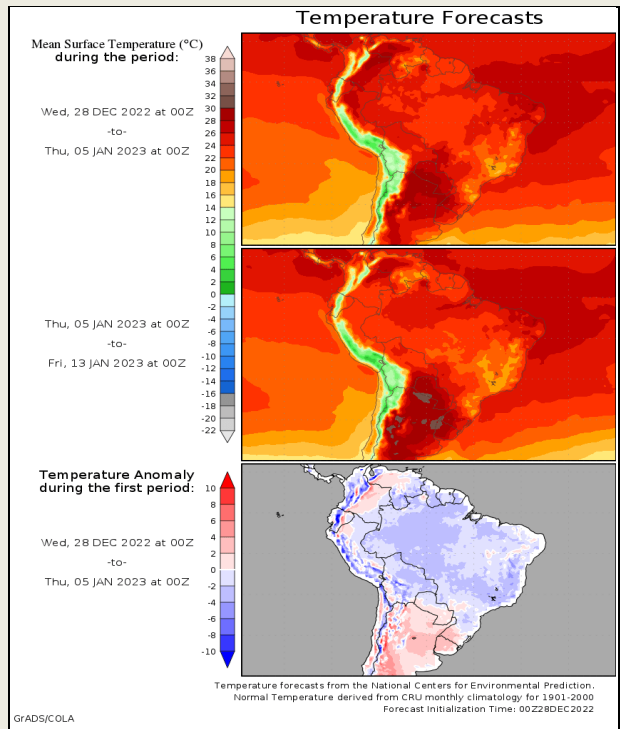
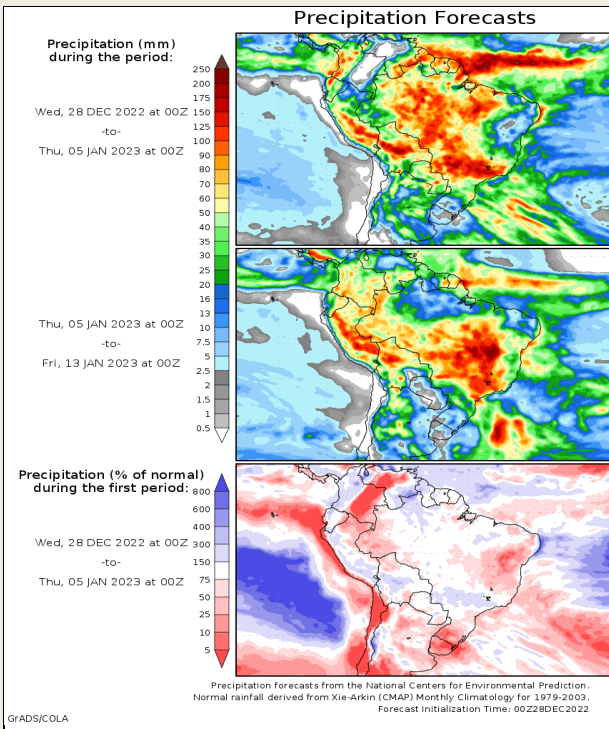
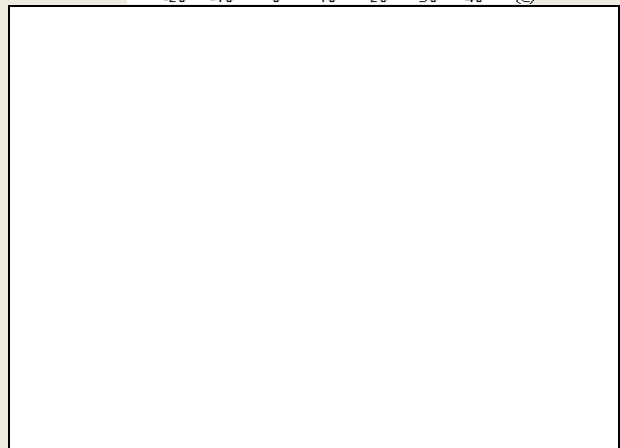
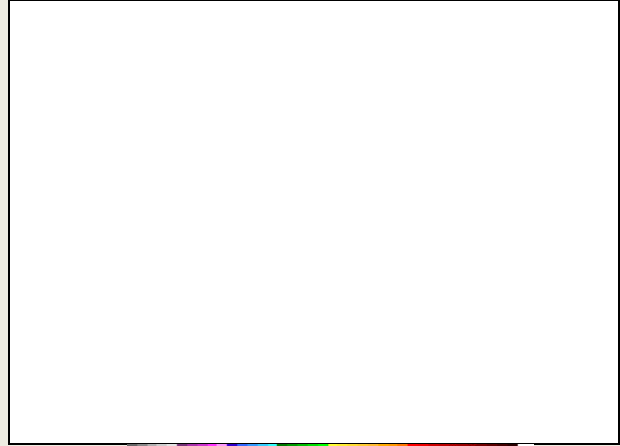

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Much of the weekend's significant rain was confined to northern and parts of central Brazil with limited coverage of rain that was mostly light elsewhere while crop stress increased in the warm to hot temperatures and little rain observed from Paraguay to western and northern Rio Grande do Sul. Much of Brazil will see regular rounds of rain and favorable conditions for crop development through the next two weeks while Paraguay to Rio Grande do Sul where two rounds of timely rain may prevent significant increases in crop stress, but greater rain will be needed soon.

ARGENTINA: Beneficial rain fell on much of Argentina during the weekend, but outside of some pockets in northern and southeastern areas, much of the rain was light the moisture was quickly lost to evaporation. The one round of organized rain expected during the next two weeks is not likely to be great enough to prevent overall increases in crop stress and declines in yield potentials as crop conditions should deteriorate before this weekend's rain and should decline again when the moisture is lost to evaporation next week.

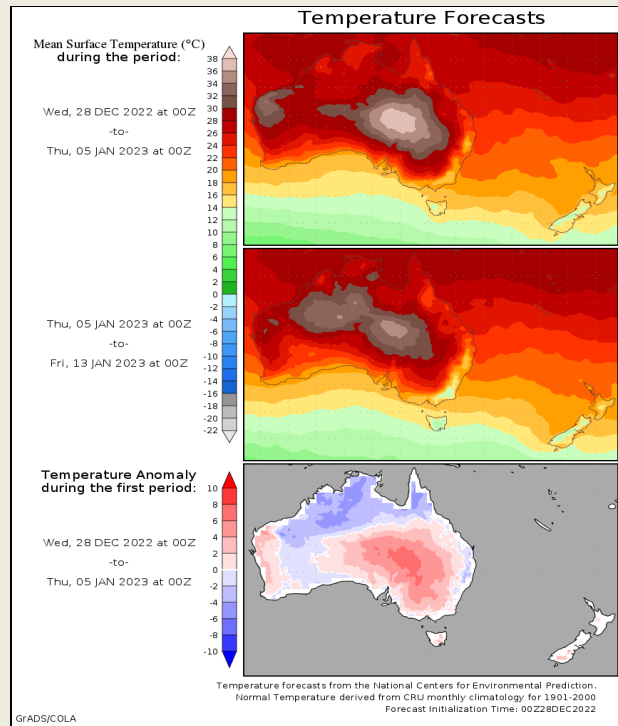
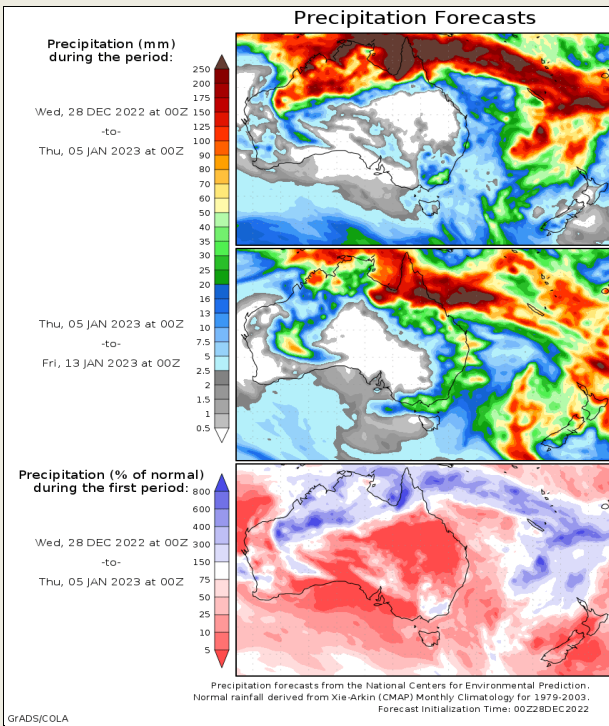
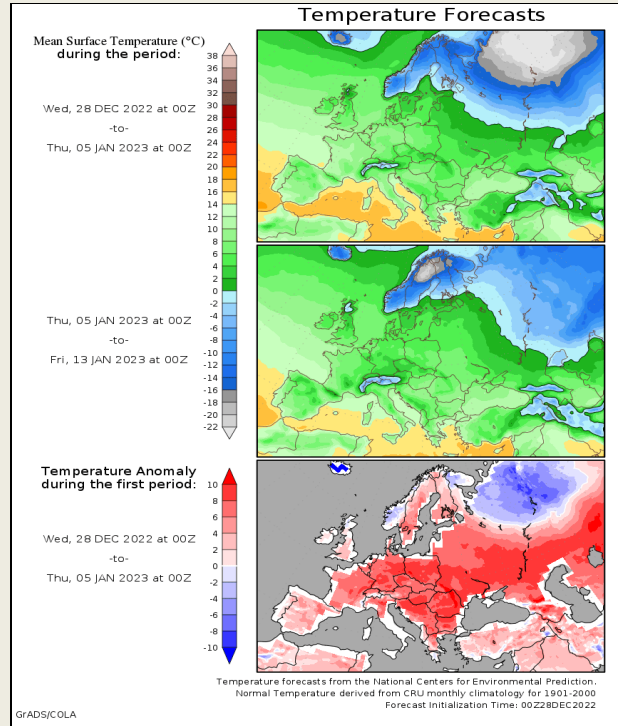
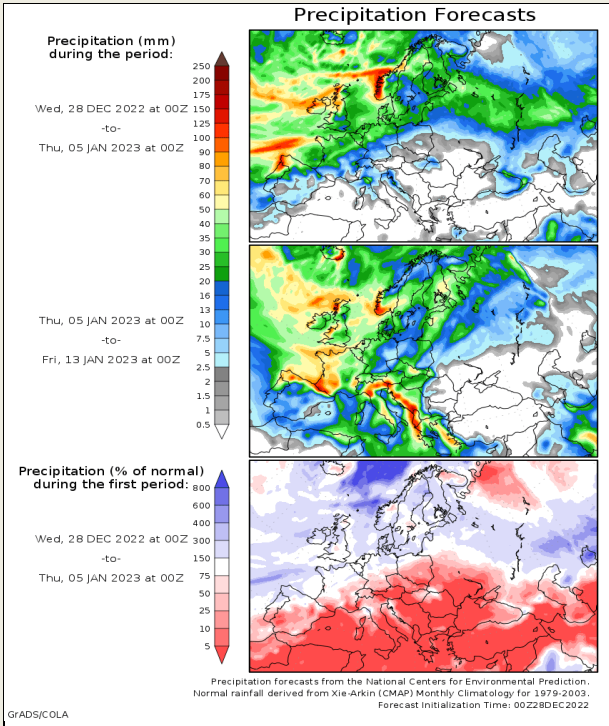

Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE : Southern Europe was mostly dry during the Friday through Monday period. There were a few showers in the Balkan Countries with moisture totals to 0.39 inch and a few areas in of heavy rain continued in northern Portugal and far northwestern Spain where upwards of 4.00 to 5.00 inches resulted. Most of the significant precipitation during the holiday weekend occurred from the U.K. and central and northern France to southern Scandinavia and the Baltic Plain where moisture totals of 0.40 to 1.18 inches resulted.

AUSTRALIA : The need for rain is increasing for summer crop production areas of the east. Very little rain is expected in the next seven days. This is not a high concern as of right now; however, more rain will be needed in January to prevent crop stress from rising more. The dryness will continue to be good for fieldwork advancement though.
