
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
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
South Africa - Weather


SOUTH AFRICA: The main coarse grain and oilseed production areas in South Africa will continue to receive rain on a frequent basis through the middle of next week. Soil moisture will increase or remain at adequate to excessive levels in most locations. The environment will remain favorable for aggressive crop growth. Production potentials remain favorable this season. Eastern and central South Africa will see several waves of rain through the middle of next week o A series of disturbances will generate scattered showers and thunderstorms through the end of the weekend before drier weather evolves early next week o Moisture totals by next Wednesday morning will range from 0.75-4.00" with local amounts over 6.00" in Mpumalanga, Limpopo, and neighboring areas • Western South Africa will also have a few opportunities for rain during the coming week o Much of the precipitation will occur Thursday into Saturday o Portions of eastern Northern Cape and eastern Western Cape will receive 0.10-0.75" and locally greater amounts by next Wednesday morning

Most other areas will not receive enough rain to counter evaporation









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
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
United States of America - Weather


U.S. MIDWEST: Additional rain is expected into Thursday in much of Argentina outside of La Pampa and Buenos Aires and at least temporary improvements in crop and soil conditions will result. A drier weather pattern will resume Friday through Feb. 24 and despite cooler temperatures along with the recent and additional rain this week, some crops will likely become stressed again as many areas did and will not receive enough rain to induce more than temporary increases in soil moisture.

U.S. DELTA: The Delta and the Southeast will see regular rounds of precipitation during the next two weeks that should not bring enough moisture to cause serious flooding, but the region may still be left vulnerable to significant flooding if a heavy rain event were to occur in early March. O Drier weather will be needed soon to allow streams to recede as well as to improve conditions for early-season fieldwork.









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
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
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
South America - Weather


BRAZIL: Frequent rounds of showers and thunderstorms will occur during the next two weeks from Mato Grosso and Mato Grosso do Sul to Goias, southern Minas Gerais, Sao Paulo, and northern Parana where harvesting of soybeans and planting of Safrinha corn will be slowed. Some fieldwork will advance around the rain, but longer stretches of dry weather will be needed soon to ensure soybeans are harvested in time to allow the Safrinha corn crop to be planted during the favorable period. Rain will be lighter and less frequent in surrounding areas where enough precipitation is expected to favorably support the needs of crops.

ARGENTINA: Additional rain is expected into Thursday in much of Argentina outside of La Pampa and Buenos Aires and at least temporary improvements in crop and soil conditions will result. A drier weather pattern will resume Friday through Feb. 24 and despite cooler temperatures along with the recent and additional rain this week, some crops will likely become stressed again as many areas did and will not receive enough rain to induce more than temporary increases in soil moisture.










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
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
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
Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE: Some rain and snow will occur in parts of the region daily through Thursday o Much of this will still be erratic with limited coverage o Total moisture will vary from 0.10 to 0.75 inch with around 50% coverage D Some local amounts of 1.00 to 2.00 inches mainly in eastern areas • Not much precipitation is likely in the second week, Feb. 3 – 10 o Below average total moisture is expected across most of the region AUSTRALIA: Rainfall in the next two weeks is not expected to be enough to counter evaporation in eastern Australia which will lead to more crop stress in unirrigated fields. Completely dry weather is not expected though too. There will be some erratic showers and thurderstorms.









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
