

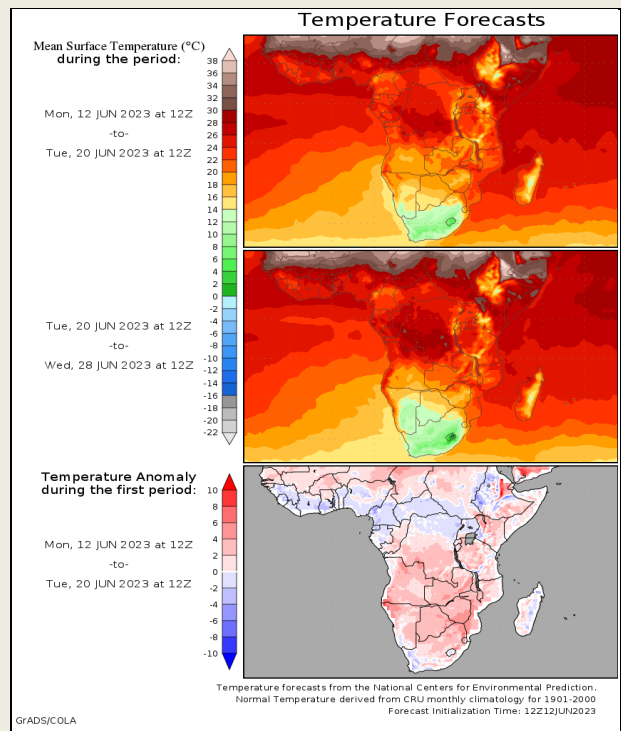
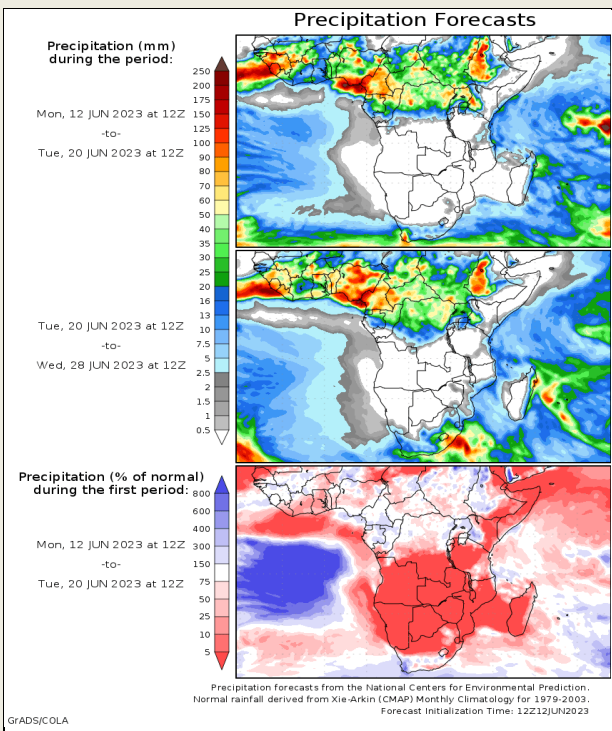
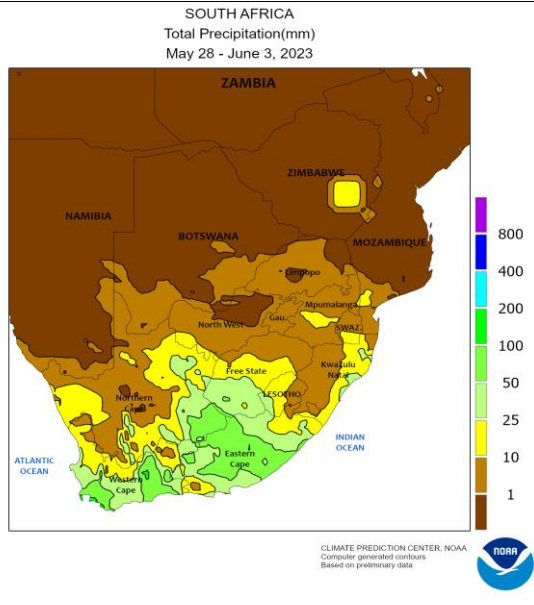
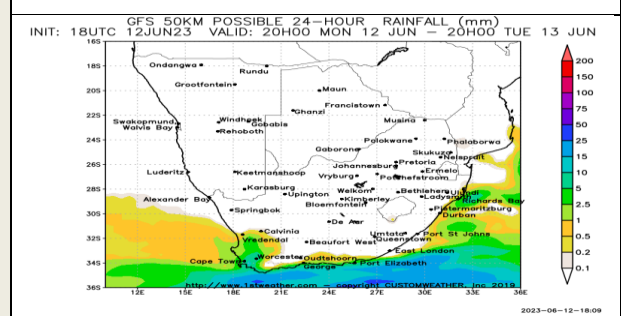
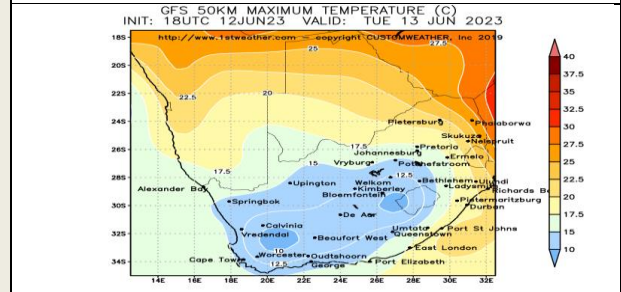
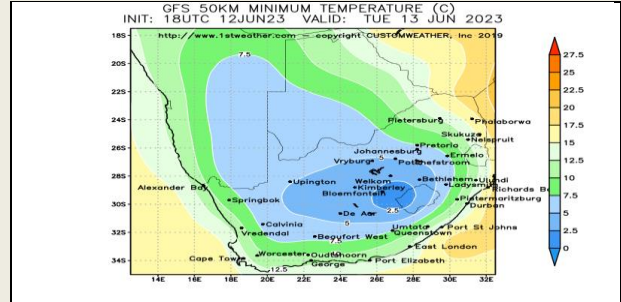


Weather Report

South Africa - Weather

SOUTH AFRICA : Periods of rain are slated for western and southern South Africa through the end of next week. The rain will be beneficial for winter wheat across Western Cape. The remaining production areas will be dry or mostly dry during this time. Late-season harvesting and general fieldwork will advance swiftly. The winter wheat areas in Free State would otherwise benefit from a good shot of rain later this month into July. • South Africa will see varying amounts of rain through the end of next week o A disturbance will promote rain for western and southern South Africa today o A frontal boundary will promote more rain for western and southern South Africa Sunday into Tuesday with additional rain expected later next week o Western Cape will receive 0.75-4.00" of rain with locally greater amounts in the southwest corner by next Friday morning o Western Northern Cape and much of Eastern Cape will receive 0.10-1.00" of rain o The remaining production areas will receive little to no rain • South Africa will trend drier than normal June 17 – 23 o Periods of light rain will still be possible in southern and western South Africa

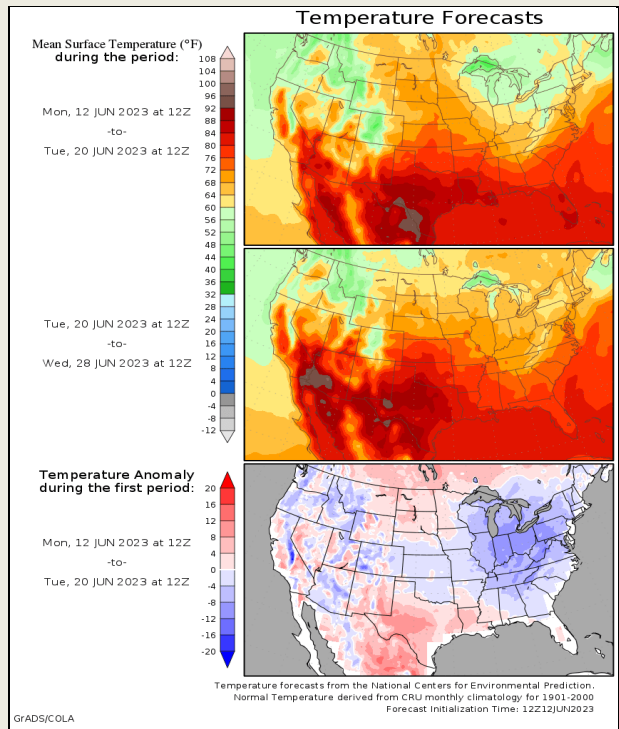
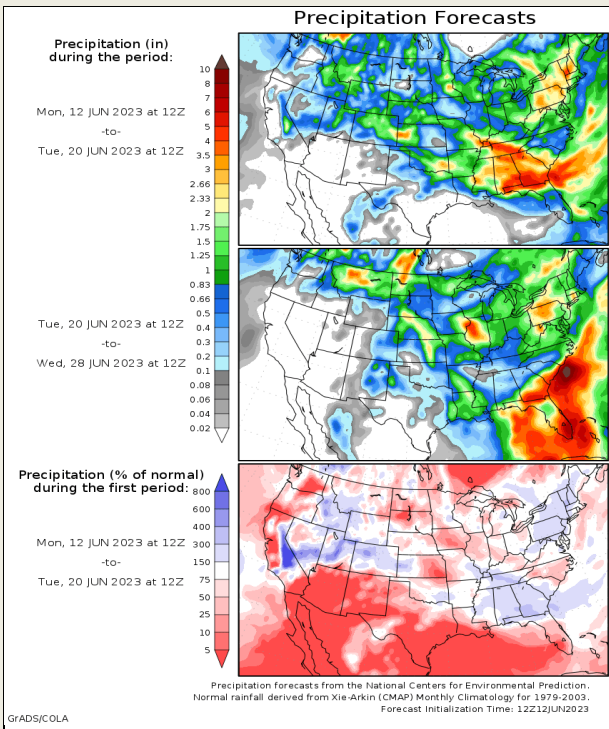
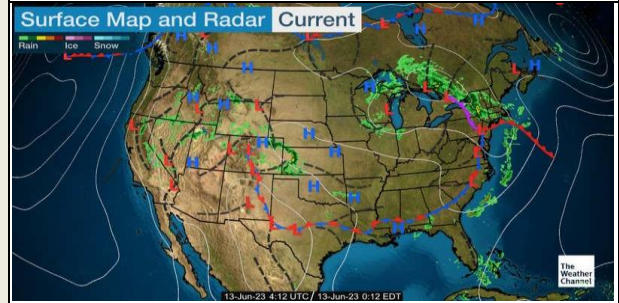
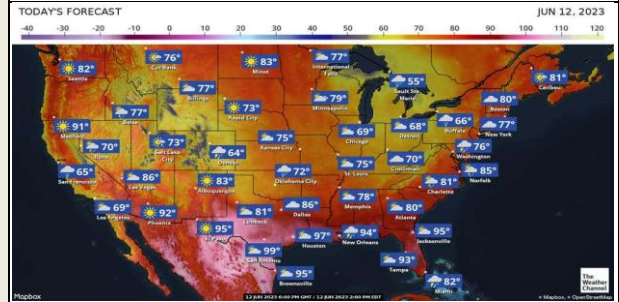
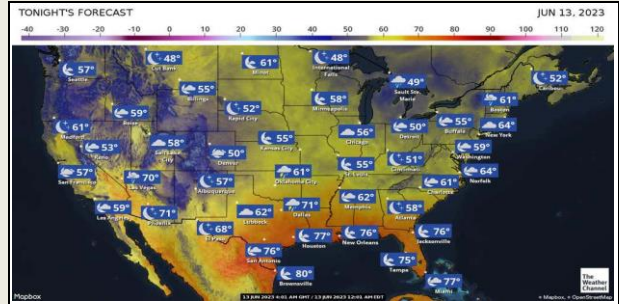
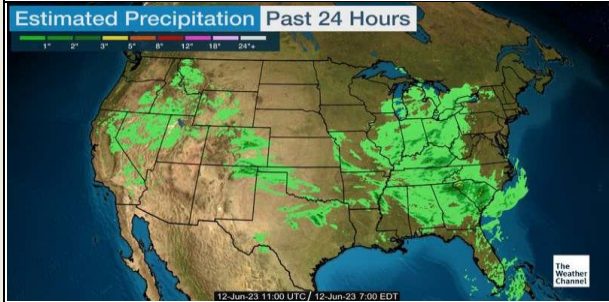

United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST : Two rounds of timely rain expected through June 17 and follow-up showers June 18-23 will improve conditions for crops across the Midwest and as long as rain falls as advertised enough rain should fall to prevent serious crop stress through the next two weeks. The first round of rain will occur today into Sunday and will favor eastern Nebraska and eastern Kansas to Missouri to Kentucky while confidence is low for the details second round of rain advertised for Thursday through Sat., June 17.

U.S. DELTA : Daily rounds of showers and thunderstorms Saturday through next Friday in the Delta and the Southeast will bring enough rain to restore some of moisture in the soil while improving conditions for crops across the region. A full restoration of soil moisture is not expected and additional rain will be needed later this month to ensure dryland crops have adequate soil moisture to withstand potential periods of hot and dry weather later this summer.

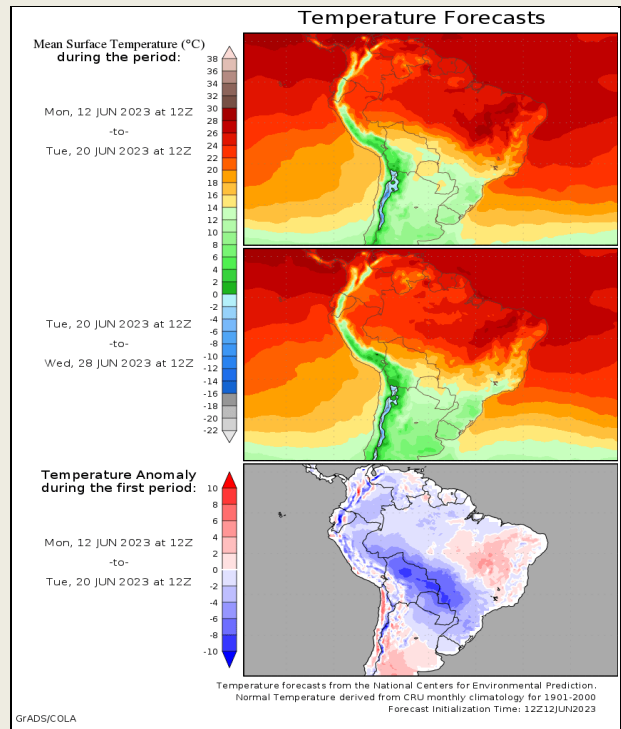
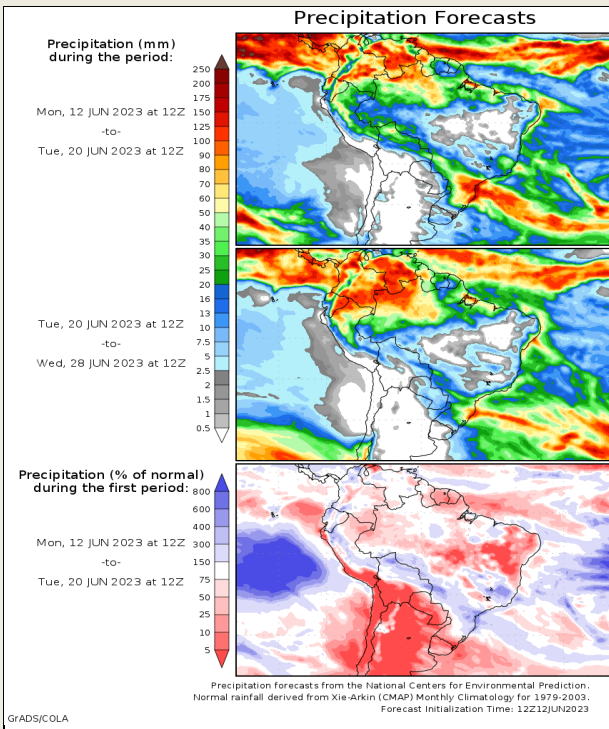
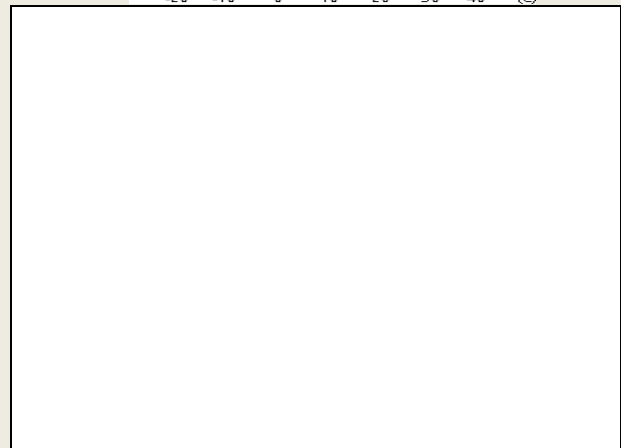
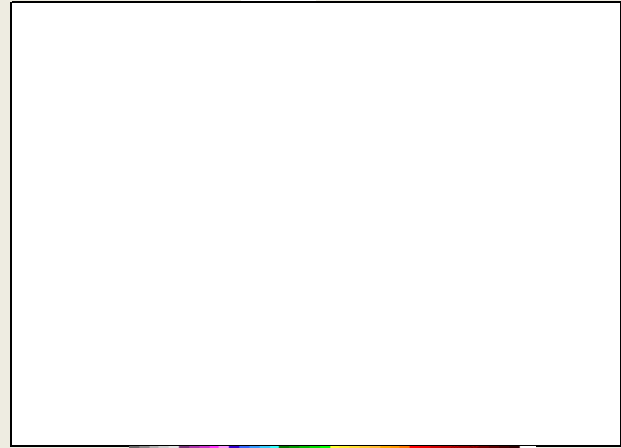

South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Little rain will fall today before Paraguay and southern Brazil see rain Saturday into Sunday followed by a northward expansion in rain Monday through Thursday when rain falls as far north as Mato Grosso do Sul to southern Minas Gerais with some showers in Mato Grosso and Goias. o Rain will be greatest from Rio Grande do Sul to Parana where fieldwork will be interrupted and increases in soil moisture result.

ARGENTINA: Argentina will see regular rounds of showers through Saturday and fieldwork will be interrupted, but most of the rain should not be great enough to prevent fieldwork from advancing between rounds of showers while winter wheat areas in western Argentina will be left in need of greater rain.

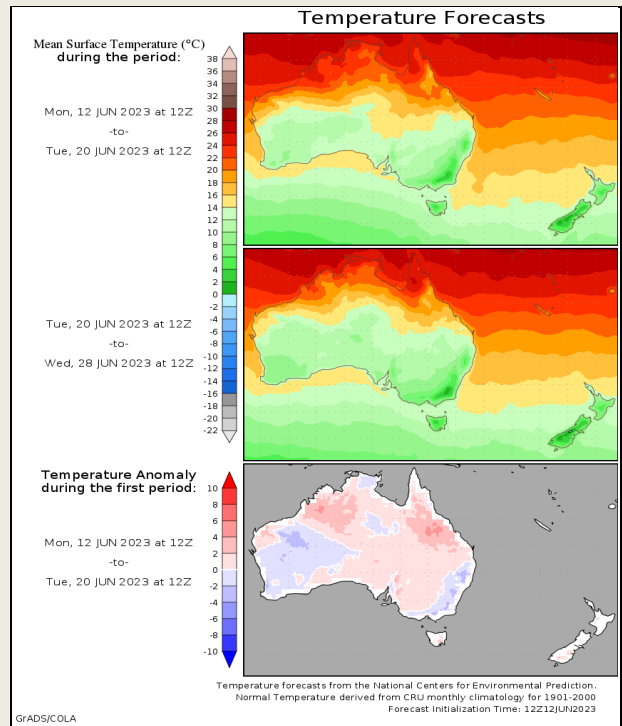
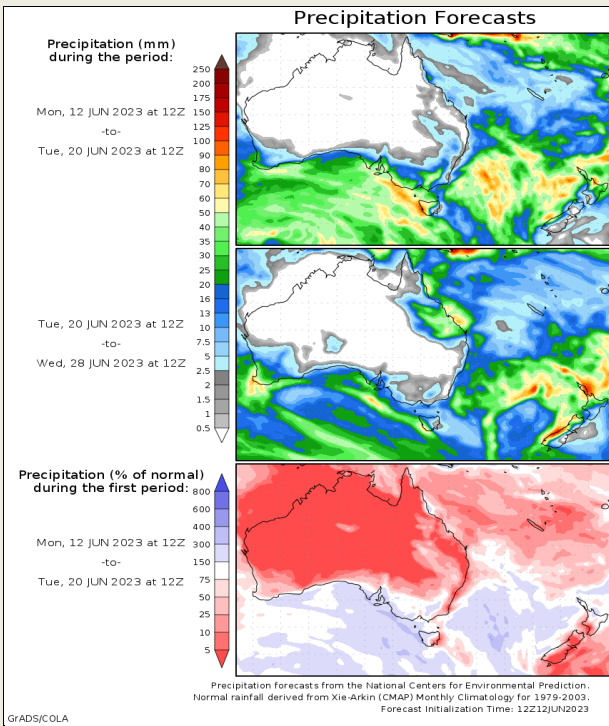
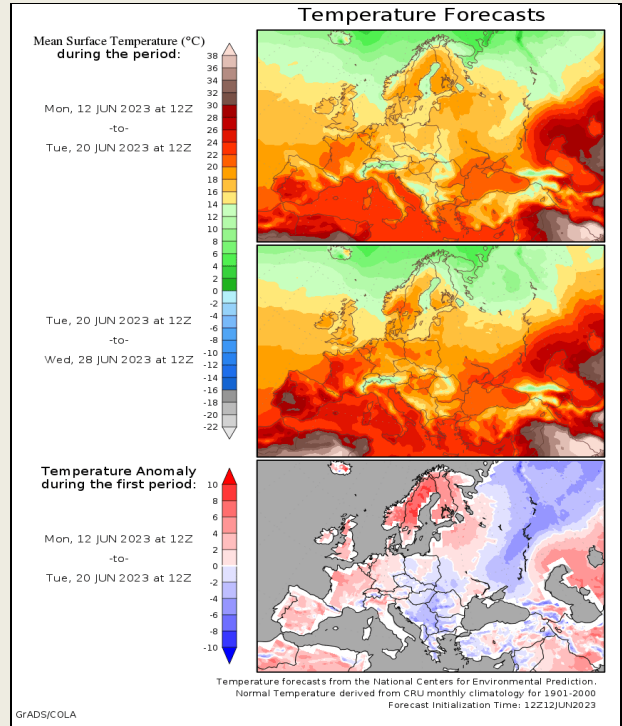
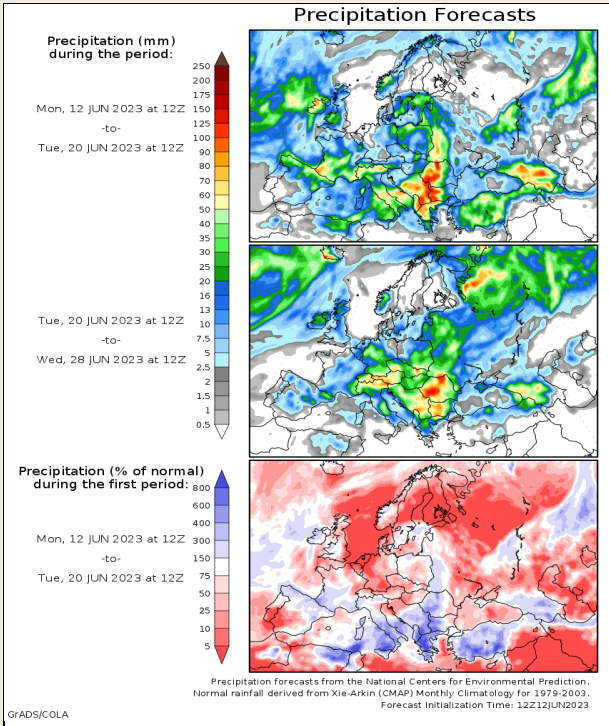

EUROPE : Rainfall will still be greatest in the southern half of the region the next seven days; however, some increase of rain is likely to start gradually happening in the north. Rain in the north will be beneficial due to drying that has occurred in the last couple of weeks. Some additional fieldwork delays will occur in the south.

AUSTRALIA : Not much rain is expected in the next seven days. Recent rainfall has been helpful though for increasing topsoil moisture in the south and improving conditions for establishment of crops. Greater rainfall is still needed in some areas though, especially Queensland.
