

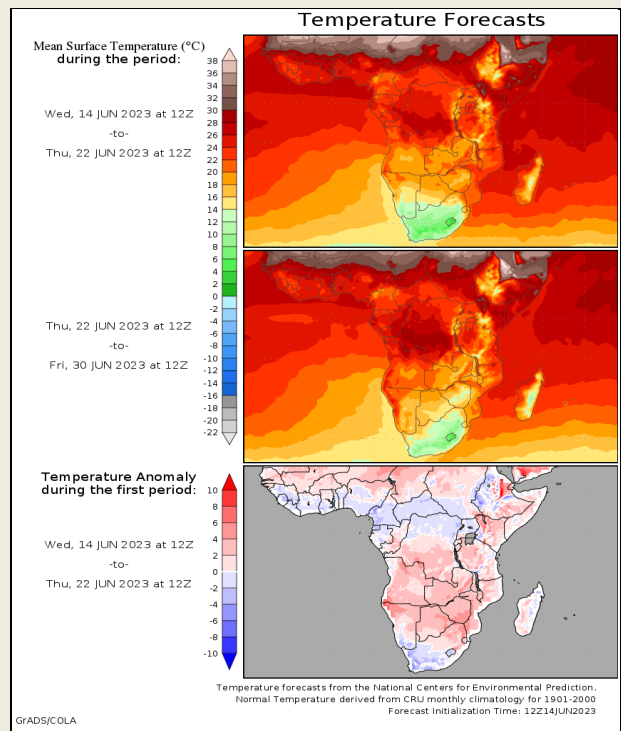
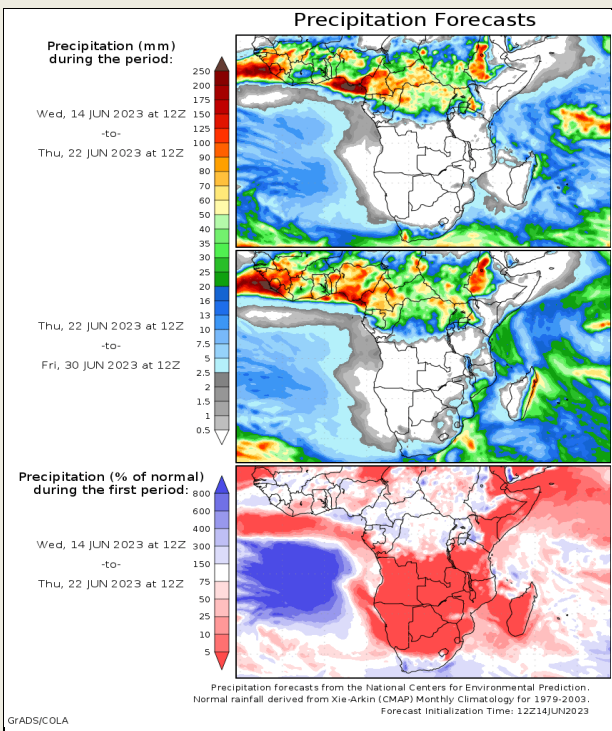
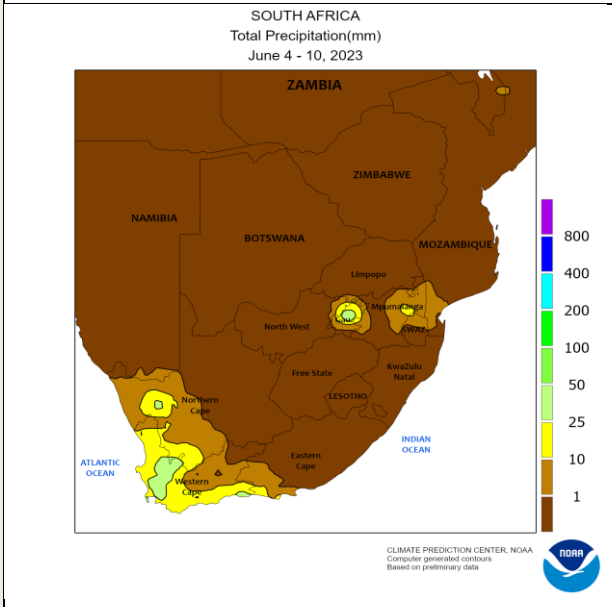
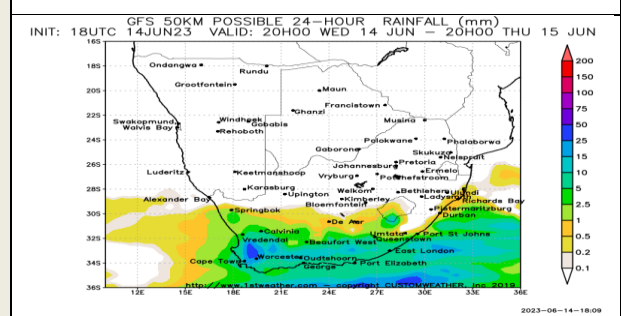
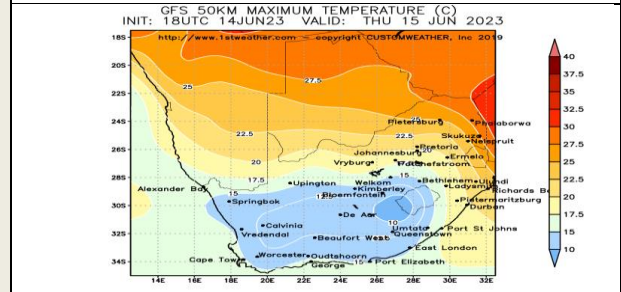
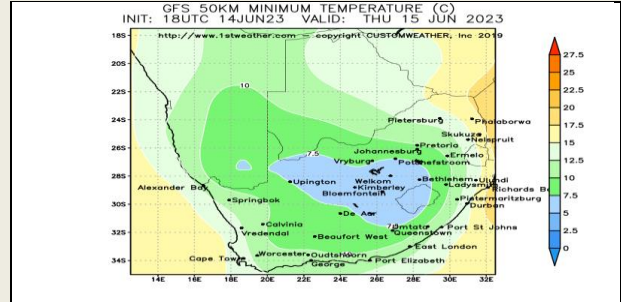


# **Weather Report**

# South Africa - Weather

**SOUTH AFRICA :** Western Cape, Eastern Cape, and neighboring areas in Northern Cape will continue to see waves of rain through the middle of next week. The moisture will continue to promote a good environment for winter wheat growth. The remaining locations will be drier biased during this time. Late-season harvesting will advance with few disruptions. The winter wheat in Free State would benefit from a good shot of rain, though crop prospects are still favorable. South Africa will see varying amounts of rain through the middle of next week. Disturbances tracking near the country will generate erratic rainfall for western and southern South Africa on a frequent basis. Western Cape will receive 0.75-4.00" of rain with local amounts of 6.00" or more in the southwest corner by next Wednesday morning. Western and southern Northern Cape and portions of Eastern Cape will receive 0.25-1.50" of rain. The remaining production areas in South Africa will be dry or mostly dry during the coming week. Any rain that does occur will be lost to evaporation. Periods of light rain will still be possible in southern and western South Africa.

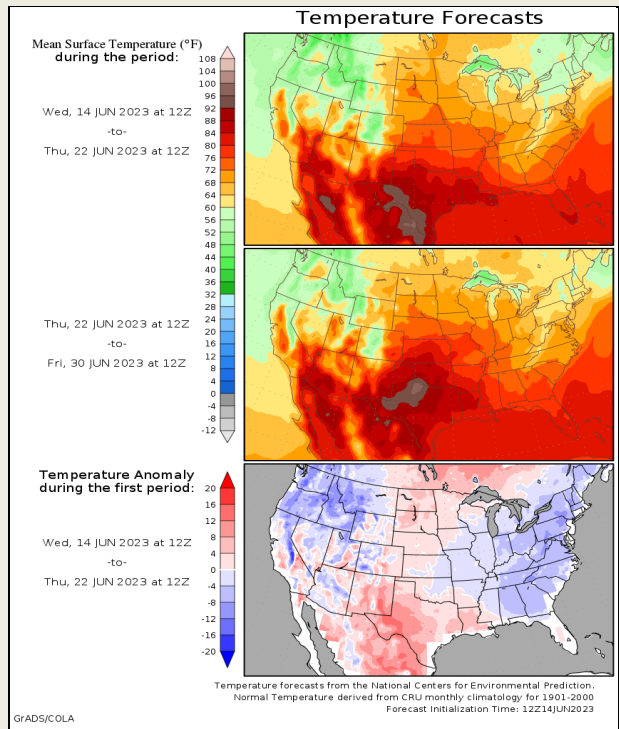
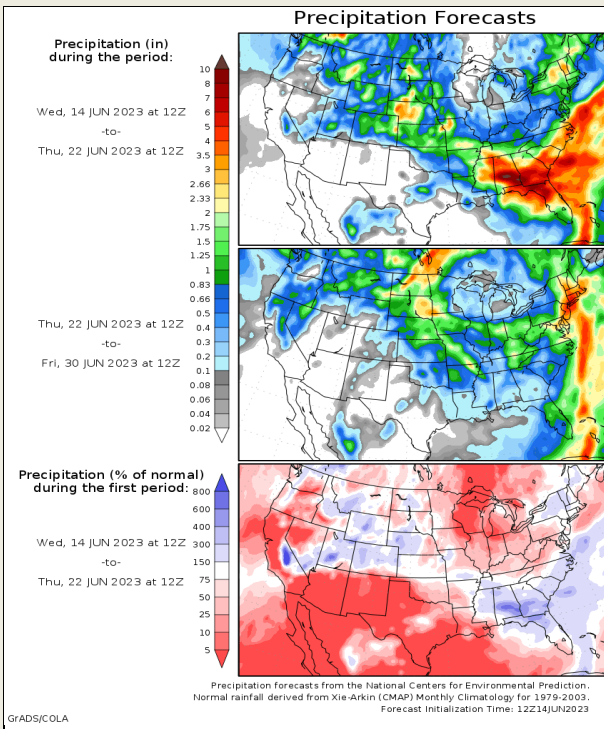
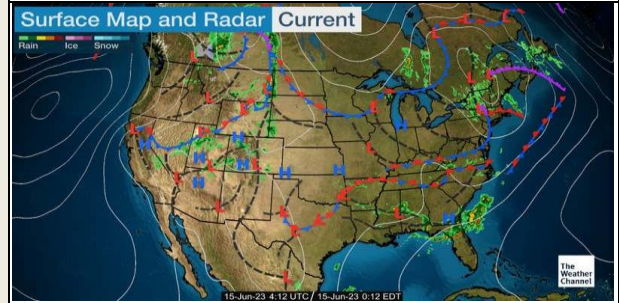
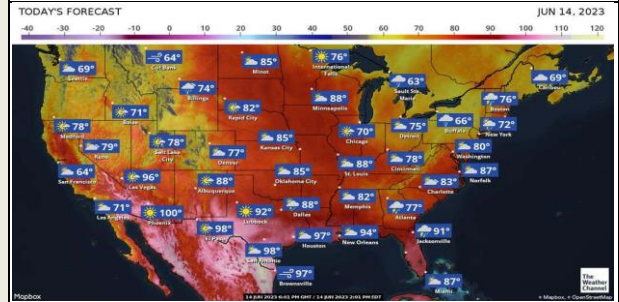
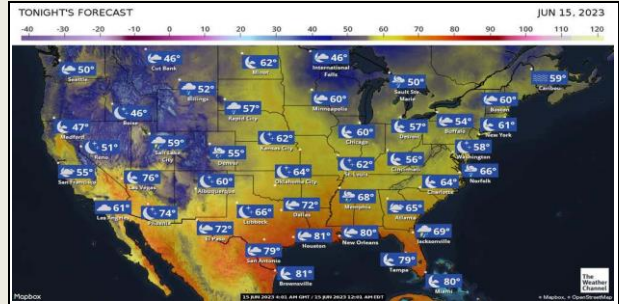
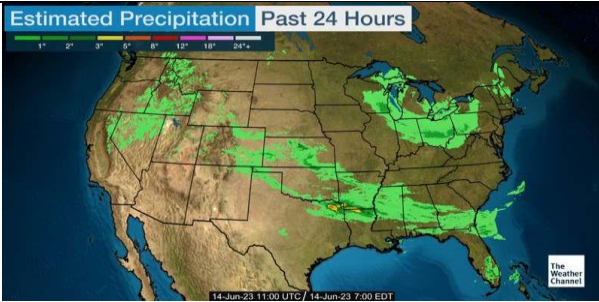

# United States of America - Weather

**U.S. MIDWEST :** An important rain event Saturday through Monday will ensure most western and southern areas have adequate soil moisture to prevent serious crop stress during the next ten days. o The soil is dry enough in a large part of the region that follow-up rain will be needed soon to prevent rising levels of crop stress. o Additional showers Tuesday into next Wednesday in the southeastern Midwest and June 22-24 in the northwestern Corn Belt will buy crops more time before serious crop stress evolves.

**U.S. DELTA :** Today's forecast is wetter overall than what was advertised earlier this week and significant relief from dryness is expected to result from frequent rounds of showers and thunderstorms in the Delta and the Southeast during the next ten days. o Some local flooding is possible during the next few days from parts of west-central Mississippi and nearby areas to southern Georgia and portions of northern Florida.

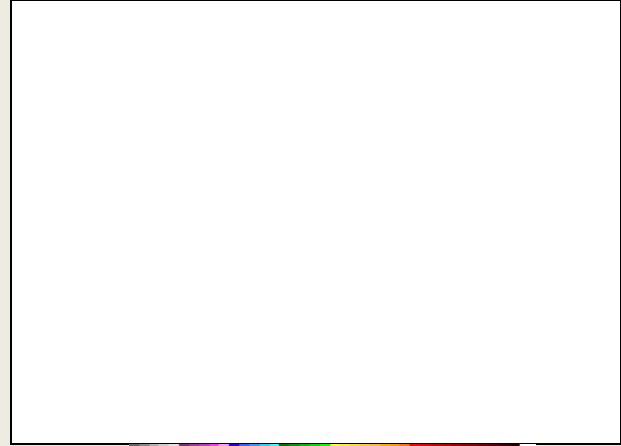

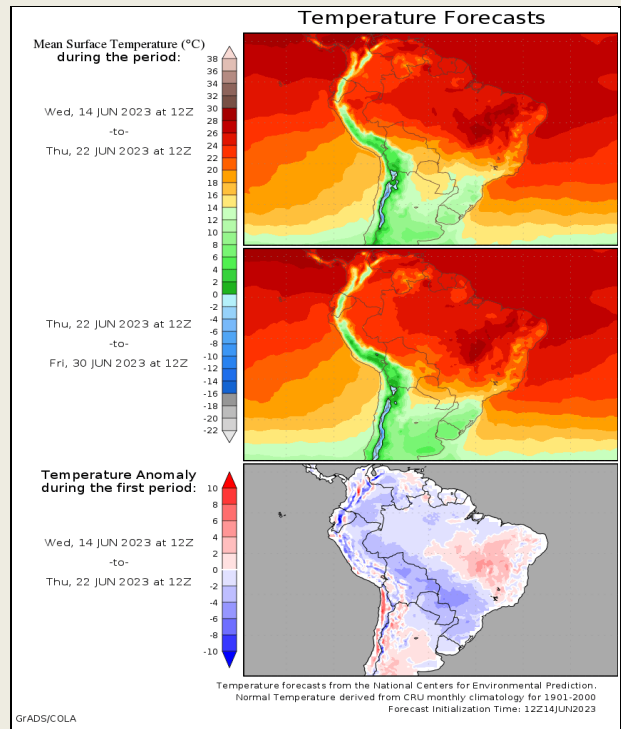
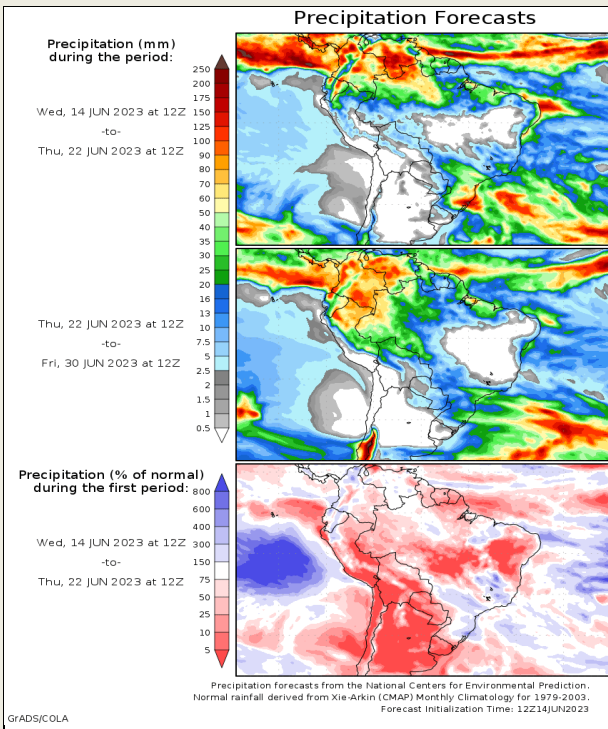


## South America - Weather

**BRAZIL:** Paraguay and southern into central Brazil will see a few rounds of rain during the next two weeks with northeastern Brazil seeing rain Friday through Monday. The rain will be beneficial for winter crops while slowing fieldwork with the moisture coming too late to benefit most Safinha corn. **ARGENTINA:** Argentina will see dry weather and favorable conditions for fieldwork through much of the next two weeks with a few light showers on occasion that should not bring enough rain to significantly impact crops or field conditions while winter wheat areas in western Argentina will be left in need of greater rain.

**EUROPE :** Rainfall will still be greatest in the southern half of the region the next seven days; however, some increase of rain is likely to start gradually happening in the north. Rain in the north will be beneficial due to drying that has occurred in the last couple of weeks. Some additional fieldwork delays will occur in the south.

**AUSTRALIA :** Rain shower activity in the next seven days is expected in southern production areas. This will be good for winter crops; though, Queensland, northern New South Wales, and some of South Australia will continue to be in need greater rainfall.
