



The rain-fed wheat in Free State would still benefit from a little more rain later this month into August. 🛙 South Africa will see a mix of rain and sunshine this week o A frontal boundary will ther promote light and erratic rain overnight tonight into Wednesday for western and southern South Africa o Erratic rain will evolve for eastern and central South Africa Thursday and Friday as a disturbance passes over the region 🛛 Portions of North West, Limpopo, Free State, and Mpumalanga will receive 0.25-1.50" of rain with locally greater amounts by next Monday morning 🛙 Western Cape, eastern Northern Cape, southern Eastern Cape, and Natal will receive 0.10-0.75" of rain 🛙 Most other locations will receive little to no rain 🛙 Eastern and southern South Africa will have a few opportunitie for rain July 25 - 31 o Most other locations will be dry or mostly dry






United States of America - Weather


U.S. MIDWEST : Mostly mild temperatures and daily rounds of showers and thunderstorms throug next Thursday will induce improving to favorable conditions for corn pollination and other crop evelopment in much of the region. o Temperatures will be mild through much of the next week and highs in the upper 70s and 80s will be most common overall with some lower 90s in the south and ome lower to middle 70s in the northwest.

U.S. DELTA : The Delta and the Southeast will see a drier weather pattern through the next two weeks but with adequate soil moisture in place and occasional rounds of showers and thunderstorms much of the region should have enough soil moisture to support the needs of crop development. $\ensuremath{\mathbbm Z}$ Temperatures will often be warm to hot during at least the next ten days and the heat expected will cause some stress to crops while increasing drying rates enough that timely rain will be needed in nany areas in early August.







Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE : Pockets of dryness will continue in various locations across the continent, though there will not be any generalized region of serious moisture shortages. Warm temperatures and erratic rainfall in the next ten days will lead to some areas of moisture stress.

AUSTRALIA : Weekend frost and freezes may have burned back some wheat, barley and canola development, but permanent damage was not very likely. Drying in interior parts of Western Australia has become a little more notable recently along with that in interior parts of South Australia, northern New South Wales and Queensland, although most of those areas have favorably established crops. Queensland is the one production region that still needs a significant amount of moisture for the best winter crop establishment.
