Winter wheat prospects will remain favorable, though the rain-fed wheat in Free State would benefit from a boost in rain in August




United States of America - Weather


U.S. MIDWEST: poor distribution of rain is expected into the weekend with temperatures very warm to hot especially in the western Corn and Soybean Belt. The environment will prove to be stressful for many crops that are in the driest areas already. Rain expected next week may offer some partial relief A general soaking rain is needed to get crops back into the best possible condition.


U.S. DELTA: favorable mix of weather is expected over the next two weeks supporting summer crop

U.S. DELTA: favorable mix of weather is expected over the next two weeks supporting summer crop development. Production potentials are still poised favorably for corn, sorghum, cotton, rice and peanuts. Hot temperatures in the Delta will stress livestock and a few crops especially those that dry down most significantly in the next seven days.






South America - Weather


BRAZIL: Good harvest weather is expected in Safrinha corn and cotton areas during the next two weeks. Any showers that evolve will be brief and light. No prolonged harvest delay is expected and most of the significant rain will be confined to Parana. Wheat conditions are still rated favorably in the southern part of the nation and the outlook for early August is mostly favorable as well, although some wetter biased conditions may occur from Rio Grande do Sul to southern Parana. Early first season corn planting should begin favorable in August.

ARGENTINA: Western winter wheat and barley areas still need significant moisture to improve crop emergence and establishment. Late planting should be winding down. Previously planted crops in the east are rated favorably and they should perform well in the spring. Summer crop harvesting continues to proceed slowly and that process will need to accelerate soon before spring arrives.






Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather


EUROPE: Cooler temperatures and some increase in rainfall the next seven days will be beneficial for the region. Rainfall will be greatest in central and northern production areas. Dryness remains most concerning in central and southern Italy and in the Balkan Countries. Spain and Portugal will still be quite dry too; although, this part of the region typically does not receive much rain at this time of year.

AUSTRALIA: A pattern of limited rainfall is expected through the next seven days. Conditions will be mostly good; though, greater rain will eventually be needed in areas such as Queensland and South Australia.
