
South Africa - Weather

SOUTH AFRICA: Western South Africa will have a few opportunities for spotty rainfall this week. Resulting rainfall will be welcome for the winter wheat, but otherwise too light to significantly improve the moisture profile. The main summer crop areas will trend mostly dry and harvesting will continuity with few disruptions. South Africa will have a few opportunities for rain this week o A disturbance will generate erratic rain in portions of Western Cape, southern Northern Cape, and Eastern Cape today o Light rain will also be possible near the southern South Africa coastline later this week and weekend Portions of Western Cape will receive 0.10-0.75" of rain with local amounts of 1.50" or more in the southwest corner by next Monday morning Most other production areas will be dry or not receive enough rain to counter evaporation





United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Rain will fall from much of the western Corn Belt into west-central and northern Illinois today into Tuesday with eastern Nebraska and northeastern Kansas to lowa and Wisconsin wettest where totals of 0.75-2.0" and locally more will be most common. O Lighter rain will fall on nearby areas while most of the remainder of the western Corn Belt receives up to 0.75" of rain and locally more with southeastern Missouri to the remainder of the eastern Corn Belt mostly dry.

U.S. DELTA: Northern Florida and southern Alabama to east-central South Carolina will benefit from rain Today into Tuesday and at least temporary improvements in crop and soil conditions will result before Wednesday into Thursday is mostly dry. O Much of the remainder of the Delta and the Southeast will see little rain through Thursday and stress to crops is likely to rise in areas that missed out on significant rain in recent days.




South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Showers will occur today from east-central Mato Grosso do Sul through parts of Sao Paulo into southern Minas Gerais to eastern Bahia and Espirito Santo where parts of the region will receive up to 0.25" of rain and locally more. o Most other areas will be dry.


By Dry weather will be most common Tuesday through Friday with exceptions in Rio Grande do Sul where daily showers will occur and much of the state will receive 0.40-1.60" of rain and locally more during the period with lighter rain and some dry areas in the north and south while parts of northeastern Brazil see light showers on occasion.


ARGENTINA: Argentina will see dry weather and favorable conditions for fieldwork most often through the next two weeks with a few rounds of light showers that will favor eastern and a few central areas. o Winter wheat planting should advance well and although much of the country has enough soil moisture for the crop to germinate, many areas would benefit from greater rain to ensure the crop becomes well-established.






Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather


EUROPE: Rainfall in the next seven days will be more than preferred for some areas, leading to some fieldwork delays and localized flooding. This will be mainly an issue for central parts of the region, especially near the Alps and in France where topsoil moisture is already excessive. The rain will be beneficial and needed in the Balkan Countries.

AUSTRALIA: Recent rain and that which is expected through the next ten days will support wheat, barley and canola emergence and establishment. There is need for greater rain in Western Australia, Queensland and portions of South Australia, although the situation is not critical.
