



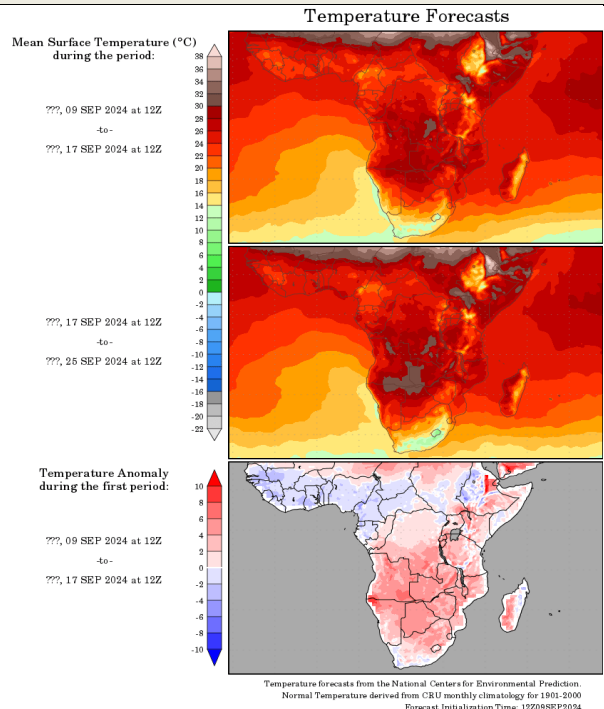
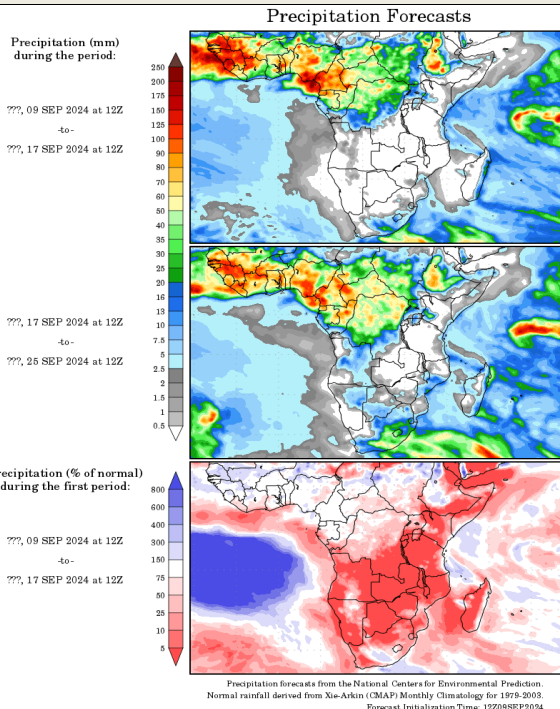
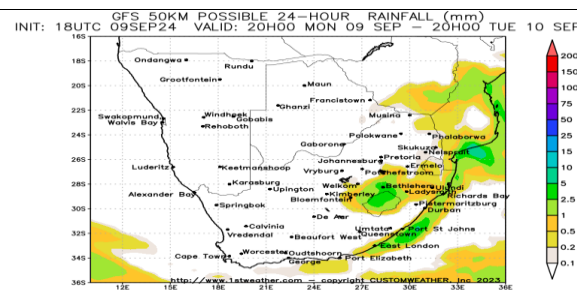
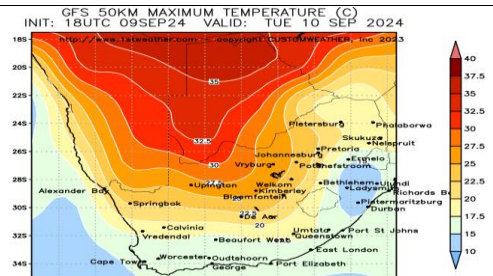
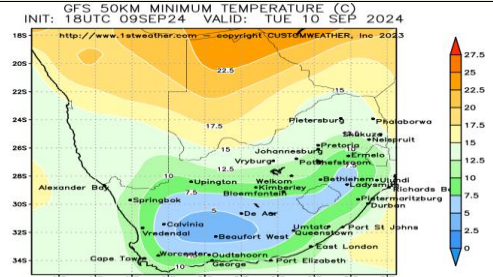
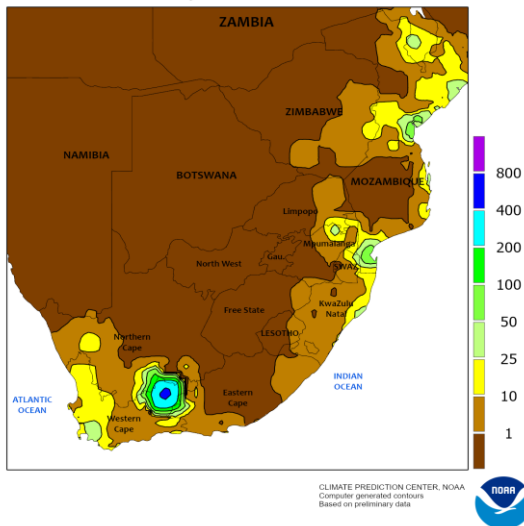
Weather Report

South Africa - Weather

SOUTH AFRICA : South Africa's main production areas will see a mix of erratic rain and sunshine this week. The rain will be beneficial for the main winter wheat areas in Western Cape and Northern Cape. Free State's wheat areas will need more rain later this month to support ideal crop prospects. South Africa will have a few opportunities for rainfall this week. Light rain will initially be scattered across portions of eastern and southern South Africa through Wednesday. A disturbance will promote additional rain over the weekend. Several areas in Northern Cape, Western Cape, Eastern Cape, Natal, and Free State will receive 0.10-0.75" of rain with local amounts over 1.00" by next Monday morning. Other locations will be dry or not receive enough rain to counter evaporation. South Africa will again have opportunities for rain September 17 – 23. Rainfall will likely be greatest in the eastern half of the country.

August 25 - 31, 2024

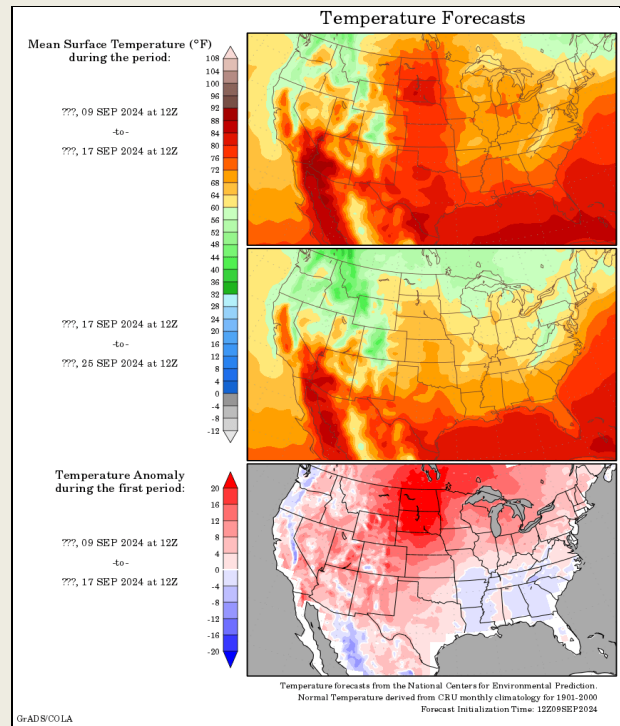
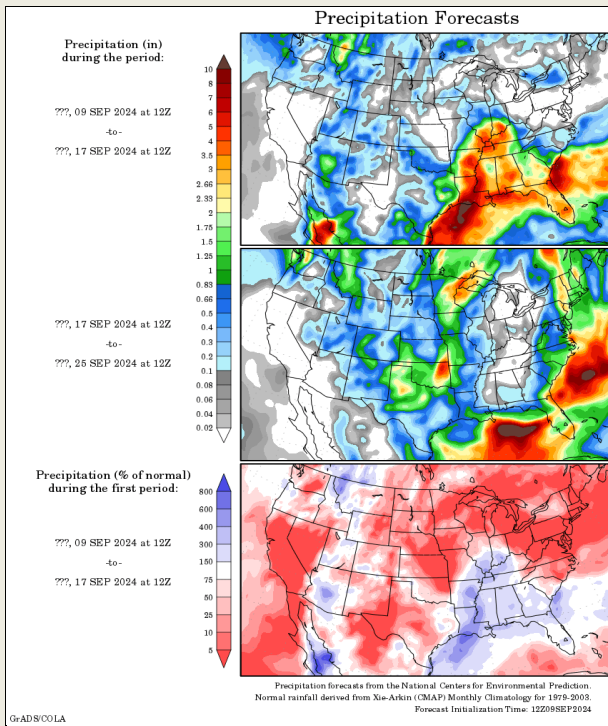
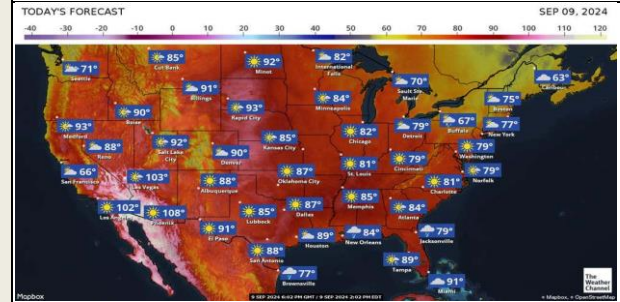
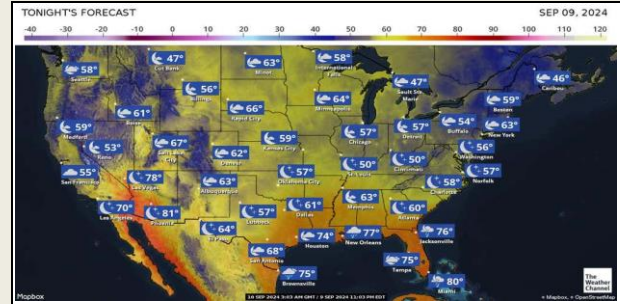


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United States of America - Weather

U.S. MIDWEST: Mostly dry and favorable conditions for crop maturation and harvesting will continue before a wetter weather pattern affects portions of the central and southern Midwest Thursday into Sep. 20 with many western and some eastern parts of the Midwest likely to remain in drier-biased weather pattern through much of the next two weeks. o The remnants of Potential Tropical Cyclone Six will bring significant rain to areas from east-central and southeastern Missouri to west-central and southern Indiana and Kentucky Thursday into Friday before southern Wisconsin to Kentucky sees rain Friday through next Monday.

U.S. DELTA : Potential Tropical Cyclone Six will bring heavy rain and some flooding to the Delta Wednesday into Thursday with moderate to heavy rain extending to the east into Georgia and northern Florida Wednesday into Friday. Some cotton will be discolored by the rain while some cotton is likely to be strung from the boll, especially in the Delta while most other crops outside of areas that are flooded, should not be seriously threatened by the storm.



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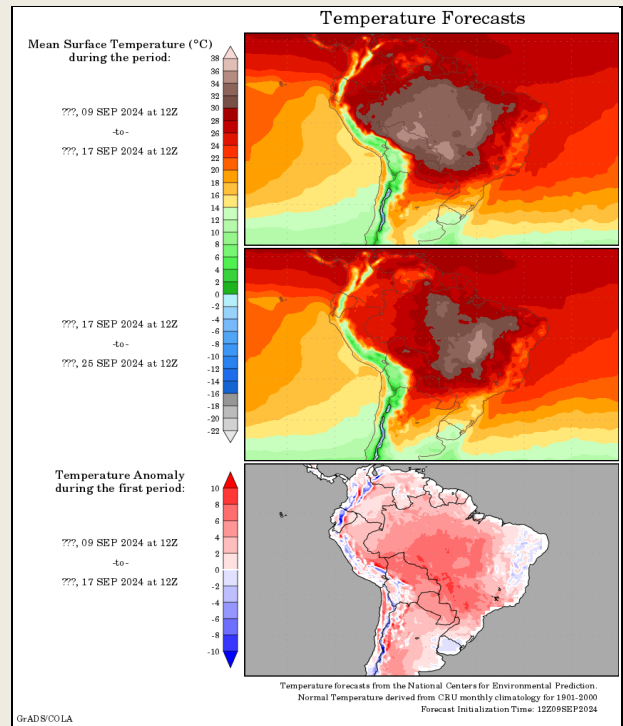
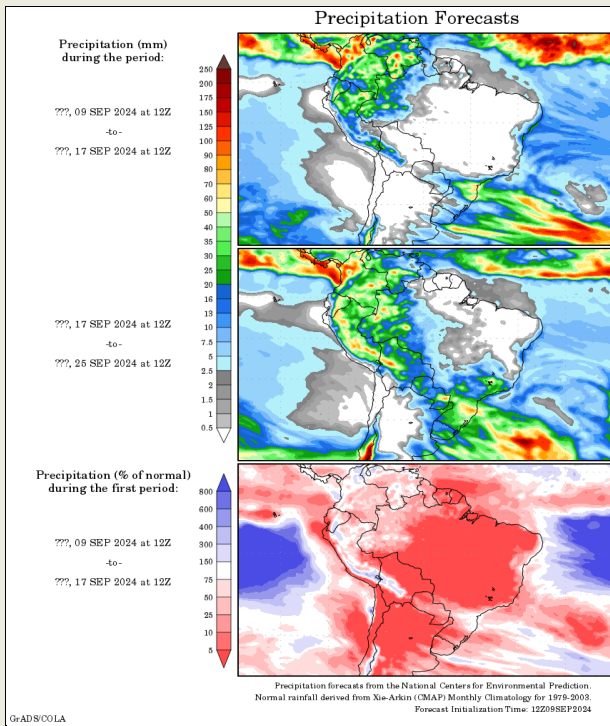
South America - Weather

BRAZIL: Two rounds of rain in southern Brazil and Paraguay during the next week along with regular showers Sep. 16-23 will slow fieldwork while the remainder of Brazil sees little rain and favorable conditions for fieldwork with some exceptions in the northeast where regular rounds of light showers will occur. o Rain will fall from central Paraguay and southwestern Parana into far southern Brazil Wednesday into Friday and most areas will see totals of 0.30-1.30" and locally more with lighter rain in nearby areas.

ARGENTINA: Dry and favorable conditions for fieldwork will be most common through the next two weeks with some light showers on occasion and rain in eastern and a few other locations country Tuesday into Wednesday while some winter wheat in western Argentina will remain in need of greater rain. o Most areas from Buenos Aires to Corrientes will receive up to 0.50" of rain and locally more Tuesday into Wednesday while scattered showers bring similar amounts of rain to parts of the region from La Pampa to southern Cordoba to Santa Fe and Chaco.

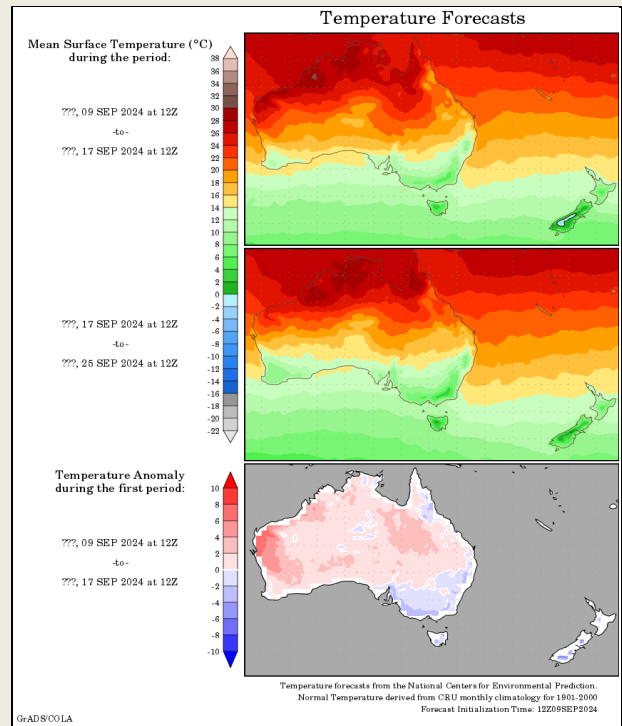
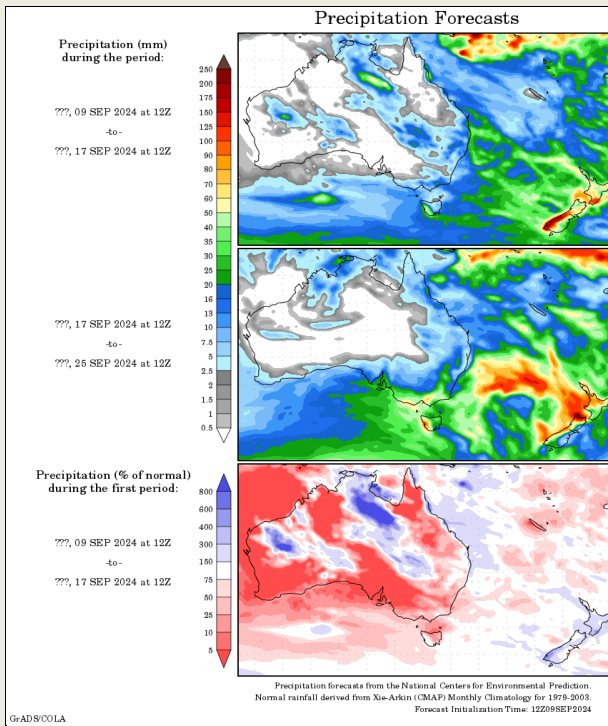
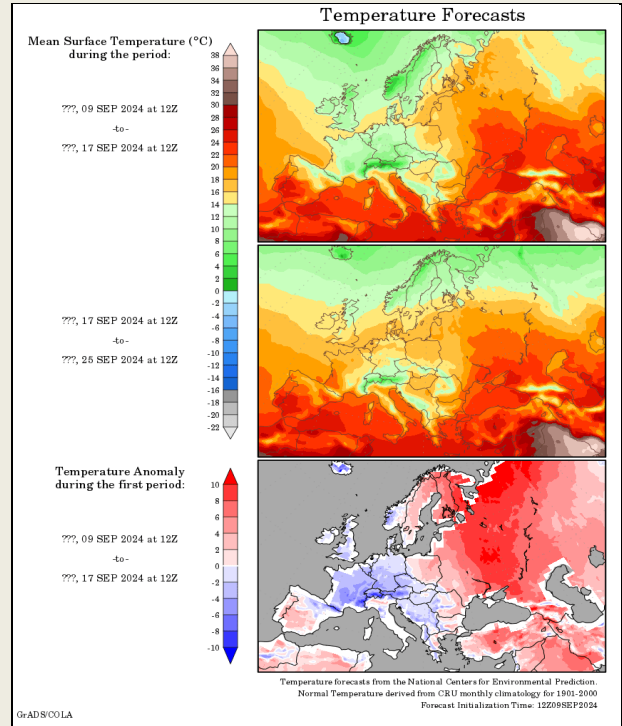
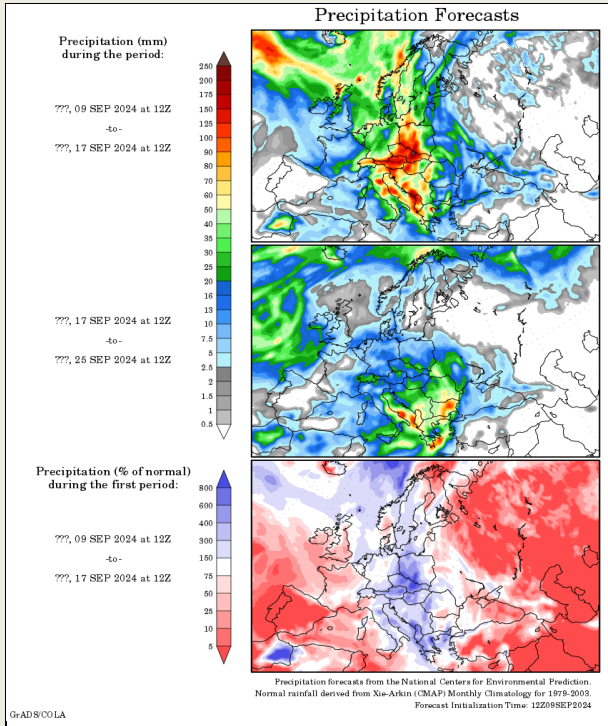


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Europe, New Zealand and Australia - Weather

EUROPE : Conditions will trend drier in central Europe this week which will be good for better fieldwork advancement and crop maturation. There will be some more shower and thunderstorm activity today before the drier trend occurs. Heat and dryness concerns will continue for the eastern Balkan Countries. The western Balkan Countries will receive some needed rainfall today through Tuesday.

AUSTRALIA : Rainfall will be limited in key production areas through Saturday before a stronger storm system impacts mainly the eastern half of Australia. Rain from this system will be important for Queensland and the drier areas of New South Wales; however, a majority of the rain may be east of South Australia leaving that state too dry and in need of greater rainfall.



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
